Complaint Allegations

If a program disagrees with a licensing finding, the program may request a review of the finding(s). Ohio Administrative Code 5101:2-12-03 and 5101:2-13-03 detail the process for submitting a request for review. The request for review must be submitted within seven business days from the receipt of the licensing report. In addition, if the program is star rated, the rating may be impacted if a serious or moderate risk non-compliance is cited.

Domain:07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-12-20 Cribs

Code: The program staff is required to place infants on their back to sleep unless an alternate method is indicated on a completed JFS 01235 "Sleep Position Waiver Statement For Child Care".

Allegation: The complainant alleged an infant was placed on their stomach when sleeping in a crib.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that infants younger than twelve months old were placed in a position other than on their backs to sleep. The current version of the prescribed JFS 01235 "Sleep Position Waiver Statement For Child Care" form which documents written permission for an alternative method signed by the child's physician, was not on file, as required by this rule. Discontinue this practice immediately unless this waiver has been secured. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-16 Incident/Injury Reporting

Code: The program is required to submit notification of a serious incident in OCLQS by the next business day.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a Serious Incident was not reported in the Ohio Child Licensing and Quality System (OCLQS), as required, by the program administrator or designee for an incident(s) as listed in number 2 below:

1. An incident, injury or illness that required professional medical consultation or treatment.

2. An unusual or unexpected incident which jeopardizes the safety of a child, child care staff member or employee of the program (safe sleep practices).

3. An incident defined as a serious risk non-compliance in appendix A to rule 5101:2-12-03 of the Administrative Code.

4. The program did not submit the report in OCLQS by the next business day as required by rule.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the program administrator or designee has completed the Serious Incident Report in OCLQS, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
