Complaint Allegations

If a program disagrees with a licensing finding, the program may request a review of the finding(s). Code: The program is required to store and serve food in a safe manner.

Allegation: The program did not store and serve food in a safe manner.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that food was not stored in a safe manner as noted in number 5 below:

1. The refrigerator did not maintain a temperature of 40 degrees Fahrenheit or below.
2. Milk was not refrigerated for approximately () minutes after being served.
3. Food was observed thawing on the counter.
4. Spoiled food was served to children.
5. Other: Food was not refrigerated and was set out for over an hour and served to children.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-23 Infant Bottle and Food Preparation

Code: The program staff is required to discard any formula, breast milk, and food that was directly fed to an infant.

Allegation: The program did not safely store, prepare, and serve formula, breast milk, and food.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that unused portions of breast milk and formula had been served from a container which the infant was directly fed and was served again. The formula had been heated and was not discarded after the time set forth by the manufacturer's instructions. (1 hour)

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
