Allegation: The complainant alleged that daily infant sheets were not consistently given and did not include daily activities when provided

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the written record used to document infant routines and activities did not meet the requirements as noted in number(s) 5 below:

- 1. A daily written record was not provided to the parent or person picking up the infant on a daily basis.
- 2. Food intake was missing.
- 3. Sleeping patterns was missing.
- 4. Times and results of diaper changes was missing.
- 5. Information about daily activities was missing.
