Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety,
and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined a grill lighter was determined to be accessible in the
kitchen drawer.
Any hazardous equipment must be removed, replaced, or repaired and any hazardous condition must be
corrected and must be made inaccessible to children. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective
action plan, which includes a statement that the item or condition has been removed and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

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#### **Low Risk Non-Compliances**

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5180:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to store cleaning and sanitizing supplies in a place that is inaccessible to children. Cleaning agents, aerosol cans and chemical substances must be stored in their original container or clearly labeled. School-age children may use cleaning supplies and equipment with adult supervision.

Findings: During the inspection, cleaning and sanitzing equipment and supplies and other chemicals were determined to be accessible in the closet in hallway by bathroom.

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the potentially hazardous substance is no longer accessible to children and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

## **Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment**

Rule: 5180:2-13-16 Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan

Code: The program is required to post the completed JFS 01242 "Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan for Child Care" and implement as required by rule.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the requirements for the JFS 01242 "Medical, Dental and General Emergency Plan" was not posted.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Code: The program is required to have a daily schedule posted in a visible place.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the daily schedule was not posted in the program. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the JFS 01201 "Dental First Aid" was not posted. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5180:2-13-22 Fluid Milk

Code: The program is required to have written documentation when serving substitutions for fluid milk.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that vitamin A/D or 1% milk was not present in the program as required for children over 24 months.

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

## Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5180:2-13-16 First Aid Kit/Standard Precautions

Code: The program is required to meet the requirements for first aid kits.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the programs first aid kit was missing tooth preservation system or fresh chilled liquid milk in which to transport a lost permanent tooth, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where milk is stored if a tooth preservation system is not part of the first aid kit (for programs serving school age children only).

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-13-16 Emergency Preparedness and Response Plan

Code: The program is required to have a completed emergency preparedness and response plan.



Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the program's written emergency preparedness and response plan had not been completed.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes the missing information, if applicable, to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-13-14 Vehicle Inspections

Code: The program is required to complete and document weekly vehicle inspections.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program had not performed/documented weekly inspections of vehicles used for transporting children. The weekly inspection needs to include the following:

- 1. A visual inspection of the tires for wear and tire pressure;
- 2. A visual inspection of headlights, taillights, signals, mirrors, wiper blades, and dash gauges;
- 3. An inspection for properly functioning child and driver restraints;
- 4. An inspection for properly functioning doors and windows;
- 5. An inspection for, and cleaning of, debris from the inside of the vehicle;
- 6. Other [ ].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

## **Domain: 06 Program Information**

Rule: 5180:2-13-14 Requirements for Field and Routine Trips

Code: The program is required to obtain written parental permission before leaving the premises and retain the forms for at least one year from the date of the trip. Routine trip permission forms must be updated annually.

Findings: In review of the program's records, it was determined that Written parental permission was not secured for field trips and/or routine trips off the premises for all 3 kids enrolled.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5180:2-13-07 Provider Responsibilities

Code: The provider is required to reside at the licensed location, not have additional activities or employment during the program's operating hours, be on-site at the program for at least 75 percent of the program's operating hours, and have hours of availability posted in a noticeable place.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the provider was not meeting the following requirements as noted in number 4 below:

- 1. The provider no longer resides at the licensed location.
- 2. The licensed provider has additional activities/employment during operating hours, in that [ ].
- 3. The provider was not on-site for 75 percent of the program's operating hours as required by this rule.
- 4. The provider did not have hours of availability to meet with parents a noticeable location or there hours of operation posted.

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Code: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information for Child Care" on file on the premises for each child.

Findings: In review of the children's records, it was determined that the JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information For Child Care", had not been updated on last page by the provider and parent for all children in care. Willow was missing a question on page 2 answered concerning her health information.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
