Rule: 5101:2-12-15 Medical/Physical Care Plans

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan for Child Care" on file at the program for any child having a health condition. The program is required to implement and/or follow instructions on the JFS 01236 for a child with a health condition.



<u>Finding</u>: A written, signed and dated JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan for Child Care" must be on file for any child having health conditions which require monitoring for symptoms, or a medical procedure be performed, or ongoing administration of medication or medical foods at the program. In review of the children's records, it was determined that the required written information was either not on file, implemented or followed, for at least one child indicated on the Children Records Review, as noted in number(s) 7 (one plan had "as needed" without symptoms); 8 (conflicting dose information); 13; 29 below:

- 1. No plan was on file.
- 2. Child's name was missing.
- 3. Child's date of birth was missing.
- 4. Name of the condition was missing.
- 5. Indication if medication is required was missing.
- 6. Symptoms to watch for were missing.
- 7. Directions for when should the medication or medical food be administered were missing.
- 8. Instructions for administration were missing.
- 9. Conditions that trigger the need for medication or medical foods were missing.
- 10. Expected results of the medication or medical food were missing.
- 11. Actions to be taken if the symptoms do not subside were missing.
- 12. Activities, foods, environmental conditions to avoid were missing.
- 13. Training instructions were missing.
- 14. Directions for action to be taken if expected result of medication or medical food does not occur were missing.
- 15. Instructions regarding emergency evacuation, if applicable, were missing.
- 16. Dated signature of parent was missing.

17. Dated signature of certified professional who trained the program staff was missing, if parent was not the trainer.

18. Printed name(s)/Dated signature(s) of child care staff member(s) trained to perform the procedure were missing.

- 19. Dated signature(s) of administrator was missing.
- 20. Name of any applicable medication was missing.
- 21. Date medication was administered was missing.
- 22. Time medication was administered was missing.
- 23. Dosage administered was missing.
- 24. Signature of staff member who administered the medication was missing.
- 25. Medication listed in the procedures to follow was not onsite available to administer as instructed and alternate instructions for this situation were not included on the plan.
- 26. The plan was not implemented.
- 27. The plan was not able to be implemented due to conflicting information.
- 28. The plan was not followed.
- 29. The plan was not updated.

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have an outdoor play space free from general hazards.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that hazardous conditions existed in the outdoor play area, as noted in number(s) 8 below:

1. There was broken glass.

2. There were tall weeds.

3. There was poison ivy.

4. There were tree branches.

5. There was mold visible.

6. There were thistles with prickers.

7. There were bird droppings.

8. There were bolts with more than two threads exposed along a fence line or gate on a playground.

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all child care staff members complete training in child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention within sixty days of hire. Staff must complete training in first aid and CPR within the first ninety days of hire.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that at least one child care staff member had not completed required health and safety training as noted in number(s) 4 below:

- 1. Child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was not completed within sixty days of hire.
- 2. First aid training was not completed within ninety days of hire.
- 3. Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training was not completed within ninety days of hire.
- 4. The child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was expired.
- 5. The first aid training was expired.
- 6. The CPR training was expired.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that Child Care Staff Member(s) listed on the Employee Record Chart had sole responsibility of children and had not completed the online orientation, as required by this rule. 1. The child care staff member(s) had not completed at least six hours of professional development.

2. Documentation did not demonstrate the person who provided the training met the trainer qualifications as stated in the rule.

3. Training topic did not meet the requirements listed in appendix A of this rule.

4. Documentation of training did not meet the requirements of this rule.

5. The substitute(s) had been used more than ninety days annually between July first and June thirtieth and had not completed at least six hours of professional development
