Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a childcare staff member used a discipline technique to guide or discipline child(ren) that was not developmentally appropriate. A staff member, in the infant room, uses a loud harsh tone when speaking to infants. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
