**Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space** 

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Space Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have an outdoor play space free from immediate risk.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that an area was used which was not protected from traffic and other hazards by a fence in good condition, or other barrier. The lack of a fence or barrier was determined to present an immediate risk for a child to be able to leave the playground as noted in number 8 below:

- 1. The fencing had missing slat boards through which children could leave the playground.
- 2. The gate was broken and did not close.
- 3. The latch on the gate was broken.
- 4. The gate had no latch.

- 5. The fencing was broken.
- 6. The latch was easily opened by children on the playground.
- 7. The portable fencing approved for use by the Department was not being used.
- 8. Other: The school age group used the parking lot as outdoor play space with no barrier, cones, etc. to block traffic.

Discontinue use of the parking lot as a school age play space, and either provide a space for outdoor play which is well defined by a fence or other barrier and protected from other hazards, or a written plan for using a portion of the parking lot safely for school age children. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

**Domain: 08 Staff Files** 

Rule: 5101:2-12-08 Orientation and Staff Records

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have staff complete the online staff orientation training.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that child care staff member(s) had not completed the online orientation training as noted in number 1 below:

- 1. Within 30 days of starting employment at the program as a child care staff member.
- 2. No documentation of completing the training after December 31, 2016.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

- 1. The child care staff member(s) had not completed at least 6 hours of professional development.
- 2. Documentation did not demonstrate the person who provided the training met the trainer qualifications as stated in the rule.
- 3. Training topic did not meet the requirements listed in appendix A of this rule.
- 4. Documentation of training did not meet the requirements of this rule.
- 5. Other [ ].

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have staff complete the required one hour prescribed Child Abuse training.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that the requirement for the ODJFS one-hour prescribed Child Abuse Training was not met as noted in number 1 below:

- 1. The training was not completed within sixty days of hire;
- 2. The training expired, as it is only valid for two years;
- 3. Not all administrators, Child Care Staff Members, and substitutes have completed the training.
