 Code: The program is required to not block pathways or exits with furniture or materials while the children are resting, napping, and/or sleeping.

Allegation: The alleged rule violation is the placements of the cots/mats did not allow for a clear pathway.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the placement of cots or mats in the toddler nap room did not meet the requirements as noted in number 1 below:

1. The placement did not allow for a clear pathway to each cot. (Toddler Classroom)
2. Cots or mats blocked exits.
