Code: Child day camp staff members must supervise children at all times.

Findings: "During the inspection, it was determined that child day camp staff members did not appropriately supervise children according to the requirements in numbers 1,2 below.

1. A child was left unsupervised.
2. Children were not within sight or hearing of child day camp staff members at all times.
3. A child day camp staff member was under the influence of a substance that impaired their ability to supervise children and/or perform duties.
4. There was not immediate access to a working telephone at all times.
5. A child was released to someone that was not the parent or approved by the parent.
6. Child were exposed to inappropriate language or media.
