Code: The program staff shall use developmentally appropriate techniques when managing children's behavior and shall not abuse, endanger or neglect children.

Allegation: The complainant alleged that a child care staff member neglected to appropriately supervise children in that a preschool child left the child care program and was unattended off the premises of the child care program.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: No employee shall abuse or neglect children and must ensure adequate supervision of children at all times. During the inspection, it was determined that a Child Care Staff Member had neglected to appropriately supervise a preschool child when the child left the program unattended and was off the premises of the child care program. Child Care Staff Members, administrators, and owners must always use appropriate guidance and management methods with children and ensure that children are safe and supervised at all times. The individual needs to be released from employment immediately. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the individual is no longer employed, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
