Moderate Risk Non-Compliances

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5180:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to refrain from using and storing potentially hazardous items, toxic substances, and outdoor machinery around children.

Findings: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous item or toxic substance was used or stored where children present had access to it. Animal Repellant was accessible in the backyard.

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the potentially hazardous substance or item is no longer accessible to children and/or children will not be outside when machinery is in use and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 10/08/2025

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5180:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to protect children from any items and conditions which threaten their health,

safety, and well-being.



Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined a screwdriver and firecrackers were accessible in kitchen drawers.

Any hazardous equipment must be removed, replaced, or repaired and any hazardous condition must be corrected and must be made inaccessible to children. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the item or condition has been removed and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Low Risk Non-Compliances

Domain: 00 License & Approvals

Rule: 5180:2-13-03 Inspection Requirements

Code: The program is required to respond to all non-compliances by the date noted in the inspection report.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the program had not responded to the non-compliances addressed in the inspection report dated 2/20/2025. The rule requires the program complete and submit a corrective action plan in OCLQS to address non-compliances detailed in written inspection reports within the timeframe outlined in the report. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that current and future corrective action plans will be submitted timely, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-13-18 Attendance

Code: The program is required to maintain a record of the arrival and departure of each child. The program is also required to retain the original attendance record at the program for a period of one year.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the program written attendance was not being done in live

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.



Corrective Action Plan Due: 10/08/2025

Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5180:2-13-16 Emergency Drills

Code: The program is required to complete and document the required drills.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the weather drill was not being completed or documented routinely.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 06 Program Information

Rule: 5180:2-13-14 Requirements for Field and Routine Trips

Code: The program is required to obtain written parental permission before leaving the premises and retain the forms for at least one year from the date of the trip. Routine trip permission forms must be updated annually.

Findings: In review of the program's records, it was determined that routine trip forms were incomplete or missing for children in care.

- 1. Routine trip forms incomplete for Phoenix, Ja'Romeo, and Langston
- 2. Missing trip forms for Grayson, Marlowe, and A'Main

Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 10/08/2025

Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5180:2-13-07 Provider Responsibilities

Code: The provider is required to reside at the licensed location, not have additional activities or employment during the program's operating hours, be on-site at the program for at least 75 percent of the program's operating hours, and have hours of availability posted in a noticeable place.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the providers hours posted in program were not current hours of operation.

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Rule: 5180:2-13-07 Provider Responsibilities

Code: The provider is required to maintain the required liability insurance or have a completed JFS 01933

"Liability Insurance Statement for Family Child Care Providers" on file for each child in care.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the JFS 01933 "Liability Insurance Statement for Family Child Care Providers" completed for Grayson, Ja'romeo, and Amain form was incomplete for these children. Correct the violation and submit proof of insurance with the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 10/08/2025

Domain: 09 Children's Files

Rule: 5180:2-13-15 Child Medical and Enrollment Records

Code: The program is required to have a completed medical on file for each child.

Findings: In review of of the children's records, it was determined that completed medical statements were not on file, as required, for Ja'romeo, Langston, and Marlowe form was expired.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 10/08/2025

Domain: 09 Children's Files

Rule: 5180:2-13-15 Child Medical and Enrollment Records

Code: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information for Child Care" on file on the premises for each child.

Findings: In review of the children's records, it was determined the JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information For Child Care" was missing information for children in care. See below:

- 1. Phoenix had incomplete parent information, and 2nd parent info
- 2. Grayson H. parent work info incomplete and best way to contact incomplete, 2nd parent info incomplete, questions on page 2 missing, and provider signature missing
- 2. Marlowe J- Parent work info missing, and 2nd parent info missing



- 4. JA'ROMEO L.- How to contact missing, 2nd parent info missing, questions on page 2 incomplete, diaper statement on page 4 incomplete
- 5. A'Main M.- Parent 1 work info incomplete, 2nd parent info missing, questions on page 2 missing, provider signature missing
- 6. Langston L.- Parent 2 incomplete info

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
