### **Moderate Risk Non-Compliances**

Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5180:2-13-11 Outdoor Space

Code: The program is required to have an outdoor play space free from immediate risk.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that an area was used which was not protected from traffic and other hazards by a continuous fence in good condition, or natural barrier, that ensured children were not able to leave the playground area. The fence or natural barrier was determined to present an immediate risk for a child to be able to leave the playground as noted in number 1 below:

- 1. The fence, natural barrier, or combination of fence and natural barrier was not continuous.
- 2. The fencing had missing slat boards through which children could leave the playground.
- 3. The gate was broken and did not close.
- 4. The latch on the gate was broken.
- 5. The gate had no latch.
- 6. The fencing was broken.
- 7. The latch was easily opened by children on the playground.
- 8. The latch was not engaged to prevent children from opening the gate.
- 9. The portable fencing approved for use by the Department was not being used.
- 10. Other [ ].

Discontinue use of the playground and provide a space for outdoor play which is well defined by a continuous fence or natural barrier and protected from other hazards. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### **Low Risk Non-Compliances**

Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5180:2-13-16 Emergency Drills

Code: The program is required to complete and document the required drills.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the required drills were not completed for item numbers 1 and 3 below:

- 1. Monthly fire drills
- 2. Monthly weather emergency drills (March through September)
- 3. Emergency/lockdown drills in each quarter of the calendar year

Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5180:2-13-16 First Aid Kit/Standard Precautions

Code: The program is required to meet the requirements for first aid kits.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the programs first aid kit was missing multiple assorted gauze squares. Program had a couple but needs more of this.

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

## **Domain: 06 Program Information**

Rule: 5180:2-13-14 Requirements for Field and Routine Trips



Code: The program is required to obtain written parental permission before leaving the premises and retain the forms for at least one year from the date of the trip. Routine trip permission forms must be updated annually.

Findings: In review of the program's records, it was determined that routine trip forms were expired for every child except Elijah, Lyriq, and Nathaniel. Kordyn's form was missing the parent signature.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### Domain: 09 Children's Files

Rule: 5180:2-13-15 Child Medical and Enrollment Records

Code: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information for Child Care" on file on the premises for each child.

Findings: In review of the children's records, it was determined the JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information For Child Care" was expired for Neyeli and Valentina. Nathanial was missing an emergency transport signature and health question on page 2, and Lyrig's form was missing medical question on page 2.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### Domain: 09 Children's Files

Rule: 5180:2-13-15 Child Medical and Enrollment Records

Code: The program is required to have a completed medical on file for each child.

Findings: In review of of the children's records, it was determined that completed medical statements were not on file, as required, for children. Elijah was missing a cover page, Ryder's had expired, Valentina's had expired, Nathaniel was missing a cover page, and Kordyn did not have one on file.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
