Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that child-care staff did not meet the basic needs of a child as noted in number 9 below:

1. Assisting children with toileting
2. Assisting children with handwashing
3. Assisting children with basic hygiene
4. Responding appropriately to a child in distress
5. Assisting a child wiping his/her nose
6. Washing a child's face
7. Assisting a child in tying his/her shoes
8. Assisting a child in changing his/her clothes when needed
9. A child's developmental needs were not met (not appropriately dressed for outdoor play)
10. A child's behavioral needs were not met
11. Parental preferences, that were not in conflict with a licensing rule, were not followed
