Code: The program is required to provide a daily written record for each infant in care to the parents when picking up the infant each day.

Allegation: It was alleged that daily sheets were incomplete.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the written record used to document infant routines and activities did not meet the requirements as noted in number(s) 2,3,4,5 below:

- 1. A daily written record was not provided to the parent or person picking up the infant on a daily basis.
- 2. Food intake was missing.
- 3. Sleeping patterns was missing.
- 4. Times and results of diaper changes was missing.
- 5. Information about daily activities was missing.

Domain:01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-12-18 Attendance Records

Code: The program is required to maintain a record of the arrival and departure of each child. The program is also required to retain the original attendance record at the center for a period of one year.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not meet the requirements for keeping an attendance record as listed in number(s) 3 below:

- 1. No attendance record was being maintained.
- 2. The attendance record was not being consistently completed.
- 3. The record did not include the name of at least one child.
- 4. The record did not include the birth date of at least one child.
- 5. The record did not include the assigned group.
- 6. The record did not include the child's weekly schedule.

7. The record did not include the time (hours and minutes) of each child's arrival and departure to the program, including transportation by the program.

8. The original attendance record was not kept at the program for a period of one year.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain:04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Space Requirements

Code: The program is required to have an oudoor play space that provides 60 square feet of usable space per child.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the program's outdoor play area did not meet the requirements of the rule as noted in number 2 below:

- 1. The program no longer had an on-site outdoor play space, in that [].
- 2. The program's outdoor play space did not provide 60 square feet per child using the area at one time.
