Code: The program staff shall use developmentally appropriate techniques when managing children's behavior. Corporal punishment is prohibited, as well as any cruel, harsh, unusual or extreme techniques.

Allegation: A child care staff member handled an infant roughly, and roughly placed a child into a bouncer/exersaucer.

**Determination**: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a child care staff member handled a child roughly, and forcefully placed a child in a bouncer/exersaucer. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

## Domain:02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

Allegation: A child care staff member wrapped an infant in blankets, covering the infant's head.

**Determination**: Substantiated

Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined that a child care staff member had wrapped an infant in blanket(s) covering the child's face, posing a suffocation hazard. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the item or condition has been removed and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
