Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to refrain from using and storing outdoor machinery around children.

Findings: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous item or toxic substance was used or stored where children had access to it as noted in number(s) 9 below. The potentially hazardous substance or item that posed a risk to children was determined to be accessible to children in the first floor restroom.

Code: The program is required to provide notification to parents if smoking occurs on the premises outside of operating hours.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that smoking had occurred in the program building or vehicle during hours the program was not in operation; however, parents had not signed a notice regarding provider being a Smoker ,and the notice was not on file in the children's files. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to refrain from using and storing outdoor machinery around children.

Findings: During the inspections, a potentially hazardous substance, which was determined to not present a serious risk to a child, was accessible to children as noted in number(s) 11below:

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the hand washing requirements were not being followed by the children in care at the program, in that a child was served lunch without having to wash her hands. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-22 Meals and Snacks

Code: The program is required to post a current menu for the week.



Findings: During this inspection, it was observed that the posted menu was not accurate in that item on menu did not match what was served in that the substituted item was not noted on the menu. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-22 Meals and Snacks Code: The program is required to post a current menu for the week.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program's weekly menu was not currently dated and had a previous week date on it, as required. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-23 Infant Daily Care

Code: The program staff is required to provide a daily written record for each infant in care.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that there was no daily written record for each infant provided to the parent or person picking up the infant on a daily basis. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-07 Provider Requirements Code: The program is required to have the current licensing rules available in a noticeable area on the premises.
