Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a JFS 01299 "Incident/Injury Report" was not completed by the child care provider for a child that became ill or received an injury which required first aid treatment as required by the rule 5101:2-13-16.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program staff did not obtain signed written permission from the parent prior to administering topical products and lotions, other than hand sanitizer to be used by children older than twenty-four months and lip balm.
