Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to refrain from using and storing potentially hazardous items, toxic substances, and outdoor machinery around children.

Findings: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous item or toxic substance was used or stored where children present had access to it as noted in number 2 below. The potentially hazardous substance or item that posed a risk to children was determined to be accessible to children in the storage closet across the hall from the children's hallway bathroom.

- 1. Bleach.
- 2. Cleaning agent.
- 3. Fish tank chemicals.
- 4. Gasoline.
- 5. Pesticide.
- 6. Poison, including insect/rodent poison.
- 7. Flammable substance.
- 8. Windshield washer fluid.
- 9. Aerosol cans.
- 10. A lawn mower.
- 11. A weed trimmer.
- 12. Hedge trimmers.

- 13. A snow blower.
- 14. Other potentially hazardous substance, equipment or machinery: [].

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the potentially hazardous substance or item is no longer accessible to children and/or children will not be outside when machinery is in use and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to protect children from any items and conditions which threaten their health,

safety, and well-being.

Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined the program did not protect children from an unsafe item or condition or equipment due to the following numbers 2,16,17 below, as there was electrical cords in bathroom closet and screw driver, batteries, screws in the sink drawer along with a razor in the shower:

- 1. Pull cord(s) on the window blind(s).
- 2. Extension cord(s); electrical cord(s) attached to an object that could result in a severe injury if pulled.
- 3. Stacked tables.
- 4. Folding tables.
- 5. Matches and/or a lighter.
- 6. Power tool(s).
- 7. Live wires.
- 8. Stove(s) that are either on or able to be turned on by a child.
- 9. Asbestos.
- 10. Traffic.
- 11. A body of water.
- 12. A well.
- 13. Environmental hazard(s) confirmed by local authorities having jurisdiction over the hazard.
- 14. A crockpot used to heat bottles.
- 15. Immediate access to a knife.
- 16. Large or heavy pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.
- 17. Other screw driver, batteries, screws, razor.

Any hazardous equipment must be removed, replaced, or repaired and any hazardous condition must be corrected and must be made inaccessible to children. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the item or condition has been removed and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Code: The individual is required to update background checks every five years.

Findings: In review of the staff records, it was determined that background checks were not updated every five years for a substitute listed on the Employee Record Chart as noted in number 4 listed below:

Rule: 5101:2-13-20 Sleep and Nap Requirements

Code: The program is required to provide a mat, pad, or cot for children to rest.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a child was sleeping in a baby swing as noted in number 5 below:

- 1. On the floor.
- 2. At the table.
- 3. On a bean bag chair.
- 4. On a chair.
- 5. Other baby swing.

Children shall be provided an individually assigned cot or mat to rest, nap, or sleep.

Code: The program is required to wash all furniture weekly or when soiled.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the following equipment, as noted in number(s) 1,3 listed below, the children"s toys in the playroom, was not being cleaned with soap and water and/or sanitized monthly, as required.

- 1. Cribs.
- 2. Dress-up clothes and hats.
- 3. Washable toys and equipment
- 4. Other []

Furniture, material and equipment must e maintained according to the cleaning an sanitizing schedule in Appendix A to this rule. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Code: The program is required to be kept clean to prevent an infestation of insects or rodents.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the program was not kept clean to prevent an infestation by insects or rodents. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Code: The program is required to have all required items in the restroom(s) and keep them sanitary.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that unsanitary conditions, as noted in the following number(s) 4 listed below, were in the playroom restroom and the main restroom for the children:

- 1. There was no liquid soap.
- 2. There was no toilet tissue.
- 3. There were no individually assigned towels or disposable towels.
- 4. The toilet cleaning brush was accessible to the children.

- 5. The plunger was accessible to the children.
- 6. The toilet was not flushed.
- 7. The trash was not emptied from the day before.
- 8. There was a strong urine odor.
- 9. Other [].

The restroom(s) must be kept sanitary at all times. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Code: The program is required to protect children in care from items and conditions that threaten their health, safety, and well being.

Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following item of a tv not anchored to wall in the children's play room which may threaten their health, safety, or well being as noted in the following number(s) 5 below:

- 1. Telephone cords;
- 2. Stacked chairs;
- 3. Employee(s) purse(s);
- 4. Diaper bags;
- 5. Television not securely anchored;
- 6. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall;
- 7. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child;
- 8. Chipping or peeling paint;
- 9. Other [].

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 12/10/2022

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to have all outlets and surge protectors covered.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that outlet in the playroom bathroom did not have childproof receptacle covers. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 12/10/2022

Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5101:2-13-11 Outdoor Space

Code: The program staff is required to protect the children from hazardous conditions in the outdoor play area.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the following hazardous conditions existed in the off-site outdoor play area, as noted in number 9 list with the hazardous objects listed below:

- 1. There was broken glass.
- 2. There were tall weeds.
- 3. There was poison ivy.
- 4. There were tree branches.
- 5. There was mold visible.
- 6. The sandbox was contaminated.
- 7. There were thistles with prickers.
- 8. There were bird droppings.
- 9. Other battery charger/battery and propane tank close to fence.

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 12/10/2022

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-13-20 Crib and Playpen Requirements

Code: The program is required to provide a mattress that meets the size requirements for all cribs and playpens.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the mattress did not meet the size requirements for the crib/playpen located in the playroom, the mattress was more than an inch and a half short on the length. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-10 Health Training

Code: The program is required to meet the health training requirements.

Findings: In review of records, it was determined the provider did not have current valid documentation for training(s) of first aid and cpr listed in number(s) 1,4 listed below:

- 1. First Aid expired training
- 2. First Aid did not have verification of the completion of First Aid training
- 3. First Aid documentation did not demonstrate the person who provided the training met the trainer qualifications as stated in the rule
- 4. CPR expired training
- 5. CPR had not taken CPR training
- 6. CPR did not have verification of the completion of CPR training
- 7. CPR training taken did not include all age groups and developmental levels of all children in care
- 8. CPR documentation did not demonstrate the person who provided the training met the trainer qualifications as stated in the rule
- 9. CPR- audiovisual or electronic media training taken did not include an in-person component of the training
- 10. Communicable Disease expired training
- 11. Communicable Disease had not taken CD training
- 12. Communicable Disease did not have verification of the completion of CD training
- 13. Communicable Disease documentation did not demonstrate the person who provided the training met the trainer qualifications as stated in the rule
- 14. Child Abuse expired training
- 15. Child Abuse had not taken Child Abuse training
- 16. Child Abuse documentation did not demonstrate the person who provided the training met the trainer qualifications as stated in the rule

Correct the violation and submit the documentation of current certification with the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.
