Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Play Fall Zones

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide adequate fall surface for the outdoor play space.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the playground did not have adequate fall surface under and around equipment as noted in number(s) 1 below:

1. No fall surface in that the pebbles had been pushed away from the bottom of the curved slide leaving exposed concrete at the bottom of the slide.

2. Adequate fall surface to soften the impact of a fall

3. Adequate fall surface to soften the impact of a fall that extended the length of the required fall zone

4. Other []

With any equipment designed for climbing, swinging, bouncing, or sliding, resilient material, as specified in Appendix A, needs to be added in order to protect children in the event of a fall. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes written verification of the discontinued use of this equipment until corrections are made along with a description of the resilient material added, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Low Risk Non-Compliances

Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-12-20 Cots and Napping

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide sufficient lighting when the children rest, nap, or sleep.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the area used when children rest, nap or sleep was not lighted sufficiently to allow child care staff visual supervision of the children at all times (preschool 1 and toddler B). Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.



Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment <u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide a clean restroom with the appropriate materials available.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that unsanitary conditions, as noted in number(s) 9 below, were in the toddler B restroom:

- 1. There was no liquid soap.
- 2. There was no toilet paper.
- 3. There were no paper towels.
- 4. The toilet cleaning brush was accessible to the children.
- 5. The plunger was accessible to the children.
- 6. The toilet(s) were not flushed.
- 7. The trash was not emptied from the day before.
- 8. There was a strong urine odor.
- 9. The handwashing sink was not draining and was leaving a pool of contaminated water in the sink.

The restroom(s) must be kept sanitary at all times. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 05/07/2023

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment <u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide a clean and healthy environment.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the following unsanitary conditions were at the program: carpet tiles were missing in the infant room leaving a rough floor surface that cannot be sufficiently cleaned. A clean and healthy environment, including furniture, materials and equipment must be provided, and the program shall be cleaned daily. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment <u>Code</u>: The program is required to clean and sanitize dishes or have them sent home everyday for cleaning.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that items in number(s) 2 below provided by the parents were not labeled with the child's name and dated, as required.

- 1. Cups
- 2. Sippy Cups (toddler A and D)
- 3. Bowls
- 4. Individual containers used for water
- 5. Spoons
- 6. Dishes
- 7. Plates
- 8. Bottles
- 9. Other []

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

<u>Finding</u>: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following item(s) or condition(s) which may threaten their health, safety, or well-being as noted in number(s) 12 below:

- 1. Open pull cords that are not closed loop.
- 2. Telephone cords.
- 3. Electrical/extension cords attached to an object that would not likely result in a severe injury if pulled.
- 4. Stacked chairs.
- 5. Employee(s) purse(s).
- 6. Diaper bags.
- 7. Television not securely anchored.
- 8. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.
- 9. Smoke detector needing batteries replaced.



10. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child.

- 11. Emergency exits were blocked by the following classroom furniture: [].
- 12. An unattended bucket of mop water was in the hallway.

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment

Rule: 5101:2-12-17 Daily Schedule

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have the daily program schedule posted in all required areas.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that a copy of the daily program schedule was not posted in the preschool 3 area as required. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-17 Materials and Equipment <u>Code</u>: The program is required to have enough equipment for all children in care.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that equipment and materials in the following categories 1, 2, 4, 6, 9, 10 were not provided in sufficient quantities for children in the toddler D classroom, as required by the rule:

- 1. Art supplies (excludes infants);
- 2. Manipulative materials and equipment;

3. Blocks;

- 4. Science-nature equipment (excludes infants);
- 5. Language arts and auditory materials and equipment;
- 6. Pretend or dramatic play materials;
- 7. Music equipment;
- 8. Transportation materials and equipment;
- 9. Gross motor equipment;



10. Sensory motor equipment.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-16 Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan <u>Code</u>: The program is required to post the fire and weather plans.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the following information was not posted for item number(s) 1 and 3 below:

1. Fire alert plan, including a diagram indicating evacuation routes.

- 2. Weather alert plan was missing details for [].
- 3. Weather alert plan, including a diagram indicating safe areas.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 05/07/2023

Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-16 Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan <u>Code</u>: The program is required to post and implement the JFS 01242 "Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan" when necessary.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the requirements for the JFS 01242 "Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan for Child Care" were not followed as noted in number(s) 8 and 10 below:

1. The plan was not posted in each classroom.

- 2. The plan was not posted in other spaces used by children.
- 3. The name, address and telephone number of the program were not complete.
- 4. The location of first aid kit, fire extinguishers and fire alarm system, fire alarm pull stations and electrical circuit box were not complete.



5. The telephone number for emergency squad, fire department, hospital, poison control program, public children services agency, local health department, local emergency management agency, and police department were not complete.

6. Location of children's records was not complete.

7. Emergency information including any medications or supplies needed in the event of an evacuation was not complete.

8. The current version of the prescribed form was not used. (toddler D)

9. The plan was not implemented when necessary in that []

10. Page 2 of the JFS 01242 was not visible in that it was secured to the bulletin board with page 1 on top so page 2 was not accessible (toddler B and toddler C).

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 05/07/2023

Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Space Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have an outdoor play space free from debris.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the outdoor area was littered with debris. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Play Fall Zones

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide fall zones around equipment to prevent injury if a child were to fall.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the climbing set was positioned such that the fall zone requirement in number(s) 4 below was not met:

1. The fall zone was less than 3 feet from the fence for equipment used by children 23 months of age and younger.

2. The fall zone was less than 6 feet from the fence for equipment used by children 24 months of age and older.



3. There was not a fall zone of 3 feet in all directions from the perimeter of the equipment used by children 23 months of age and younger.

4. There was not a fall zone of 6 feet in all directions from the perimeter of the equipment used by children 24 months of age and older. (There was only 5 feet 5 inches from the small set of steps to the fall zone barrier.)5. The fall zone was less than 4 1/2 feet from each piece of applicable equipment used by children 23 months of age and younger.

6. The fall zone was less than 9 feet from each piece of applicable equipment used by children 24 months of age and older.

7. Other [].

The program is required to provide equipment that is safe with adequate fall zones. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Space Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have an outdoor play space free from general hazards.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that hazardous conditions existed in the outdoor play area, as noted in number(s) 10 below:

1. There was broken glass.

2. There were tall weeds.

3. There was poison ivy.

4. There were tree branches.

5. There was mold visible.

6. There were thistles with prickers.

7. There were bird droppings.

8. There were bolts with more than two threads exposed along a fence line or gate on a playground.

9. The sandbox was contaminated.

10. One of the wooden barriers around the fall zone was splintering.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 05/07/2023

Domain: 05 Health & Safety



Rule: 5101:2-12-16 Emergency Drills

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to complete fire drills, weather drills, and emergency/lockdown drills appropriately.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the required drills were not completed for item number(s) 1 and 2 below:

- 1. Monthly fire drills. (no documentation for March)
- 2. Monthly weather emergency drills (March through September). (no documentation for March)
- 3. Emergency/lockdown drills in each quarter of the calendar year.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 05/07/2023

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-12-20 Cribs

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to obtain written permission from parents of children who are over 12 months old and will using a cot/mat instead of a crib.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that an infant who was 12 months or older was assigned to a cot without written permission from the parent, as required by this rule. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 05/07/2023

Domain: 08 Staff Files

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-08 Orientation Training & Whistle Blower Protection <u>Code</u>: The program is required to have staff complete the online staff orientation training.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that child care staff member(s) had not completed the online orientation training as noted in number(s) 2 below:

Within 30 days of starting employment at the program as a child care staff member.
 No documentation of completing the training after December 31, 2016.



3. Completion of the training was not verified in the OPR.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5101:2-12-10 Health Training Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all child care staff members complete training in child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention within sixty days of hire. Staff must complete training in first aid and CPR within the first ninety days of hire.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that at least one child care staff member had not completed required health and safety training as noted in number(s) 2, 3, 4 below:

- 1. Child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was not completed within sixty days of hire.
- 2. First aid training was not completed within ninety days of hire.
- 3. Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training was not completed within ninety days of hire.
- 4. The child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was expired.
- 5. The first aid training was expired.
- 6. The CPR training was expired.

Refer to the Employee Record Chart for the name(s) of the child care staff member(s) who must complete the required health and safety training(s). Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 09 Children's Files

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-15 Child Medical and Enrollment Records <u>Code</u>: The program is required to have a completed medical on file at the program for each child enrolled.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of 25% of the children's records, it was determined that completed medical statements were not on file, as required, for children listed on the JFS Children's Record Review For Child Care as indicated in number(s) 1 and 2 below:

1. No medical was on file for at least one child



- 2. Medical(s) on file was not updated every 13 months
- 3. Medical(s) were missing child's name and date of birth
- 4. Medical(s) were missing the date of the medical examination
- 5. The date of the exam was more than 13 months prior to the date the form was signed.

6. Medical(s) were missing a statement that the child has been examined and is in suitable condition for participation in group care

7. Medical(s) were missing the signature, business address and telephone number of the physician, physician's assistant(PA), advance practice nurse (APN) or certified

nurse practitioner (CNP) who examined the child

8. Medical(s) were missing a record of immunizations the child has had specifying month, day and year

9. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the physician, PA, APN, or CNP that the child has been immunized or is in the process of being immunized against the diseases

10. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the child's parent or guardian that he or she has declined to have the child immunized against the disease for reasons of

conscience, including religious convictions
