Complaint Allegations

Rule: 5180:2-12-19 Child Guidance

Code: The program staff shall use developmentally appropriate techniques when managing children's behavior. Corporal punishment is prohibited, as well as any cruel, harsh, unusual or extreme techniques.

Allegation: It was alleged that a staff member used a non-developmentally appropriate technique to guide a child's behavior.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a child care staff member used a discipline technique to guide or discipline child(ren) that was not developmentally appropriate, consistent, or occurred at the time of the incident. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-12-19 Supervision

Code: The program staff is required to supervise children in their assigned group by sight and hearing. Supervision includes being near enough to respond and reach children immediately and protecting them from harm.

Allegation: It was alleged that a child was not properly supervised at the program.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that children were left unattended while inside the program as noted in number(s) 1 & 8 below:

1. Child(ren) were left unattended once.
2. Child(ren) were left unattended more than once.
3. Child(ren) left the group and were unattended.
4. Child care staff were using a baby monitor to supervise children.
5. Child care staff were using a walkie talkie to supervise children.
6. Child care staff were using mirrors to view children in another room.
7. Child care staff were using a video camera instead of physically being present in the room.
8. Other: An infant was sleeping in a crib in the infant 1 area out of sight of the teacher who was in the infant 2 area.

Children must be supervised and within sight and hearing of a child care staff member at all times. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-12-19 Child Guidance

Code: The program is required to report in OCLQS when a child is expelled from a center for a behavioral reason.

Allegation: It was alleged that the program did not report an expulsion to the department.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a child had been expelled for a behavioral reason and the expulsion was not reported in the Ohio Child Licensing Quality System (OCLQS), as required. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the expulsion has been reported in OCLQS, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of the rule.
