Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-12-18 Ratio

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have a second employee present, and used based on the qualifications they meet, when seven or more children are present.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not meet the rule requirement as noted in number 1 below:

- 1. The program did not have a second employee or Child Care Staff Member present when required;
- 2. The program was using a second Child Care Staff Member who was not able to meet this criteria as defined in the rule.



It was determined that there was one staff member in the program with eight children from 12:30 p.m. to 1:30 p.m. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Low Risk Non-Compliances

Rule: 5101:2-12-18 Attendance Records

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have a method for tracking the children in each group. The tracking method must be updated throughout the day and kept with the group at all times.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the method for tracking children in each group did not meet the requirements of the rule as noted in number 5 below:

- 1. There was no method in place;
- 2. The method did not include each child's name;
- 3. The method did not include each child's date of birth;
- 4. The tracking method did not remain with the group at all times;
- 5. The tracking method was not updated throughout the day as children entered or left the group.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

Code: The program is required to provide a clean and healthy environment.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the following unsanitary conditions were at the program: A crib sheet was observed to be dirty. A clean and healthy environment, including furniture, materials and

equipment must be provided, and the program shall be cleaned daily. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-12-20 Cribs

Code: The program is required to provide clean sheets for all cribs that are not too large or too small for the crib.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that sheets did not meet the rule requirement as noted in number 2 below:

- 1. At least one crib did not have a sheet.
- 2. At least one sheet was too large.
- 3. At least one sheet was too small.
- 4. At least one sheet was torn.
- 5. Crib sheets were not clean.

Code: The program is required to maintain a staff schedule with coverage of the required health trainings.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined the program did not have at least one child care staff member present/scheduled to be present during all hours of operation with currently valid documentation for the training(s) listed in number below:

- 1. First Aid child care staff members scheduled during the hours of [] and [] had expired training
- 2. First Aid child care staff members scheduled during the hours of [] and [] did not have verification of completion of First Aid
- 3. First Aid trained child care staff member was not present in each building used by the program.
- 4. CPR child care staff members scheduled during the hours of [] and [] had expired training
