Code: The program is required to use an outdoor space that is protected from traffic and other hazards with a

barrier.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that an area was used which was not protected from traffic and other hazards by a fence in good condition, that assured children were not able to leave the playground area. The fence was determined to present an immediate risk for a child to be able to leave the playground as noted in numbers 2 and 5 below:

- 1. The fencing had missing slat boards through which children could leave the playground.
- 2. The gate was broken and did not close.
- 3. The latch on the gate was broken.
- 4. The gate had no latch.
- 5. The fencing was broken.
- 6. The latch was easily opened by children on the playground.
- 7. The portable fencing approved for use by the Department was not being used.
- 8. Other [ ].

Discontinue use of the playground and provide a space for outdoor play which is well defined by a fence or other barrier and protected from other hazards. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

- 10. Expiration date was missing on the JFS 01217.
- 11. Physician instructions were missing on the JFS 01217.

- 13. Physician's phone number was missing on the JFS 01217.
- 14. Date medication was administered was missing on the JFS 01217.
- 15. Time medication was administered was missing on the JFS 01217.
- 16. Dosage administered was missing on the JFS 01217.
- 17. Staff member's signature was missing on the JFS 01217.
- 18. A current prescription label was not attached to the prescription medication.
- 19. The medication or product, [ ], was not brought to the program in its original container.

**Domain: 00 License & Approvals** 

Rule: 5101:2-13-04 Fire Safety for Type B Homes

Code: The program is required to follow all requirements in rule regarding emergency exits and operational

conditions.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the following requirement regarding emergency exits and operational conditions were not met by the program in the program did not have a fire escape ladder for the upstairs window. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a pet at the program posed a threat to the safety and health of the children, in that the current inoculations were not on file. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Code: The program is required to protect children in care from items and conditions that threaten their health, safety, and well being.

Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any items which threaten their health, safety, and well being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following items that were located on the right side of the kitchen in the top drawer and on the floor by the trash can these items may threaten their health, safety, or well being as noted in the following number 12 below:

- 1. Open pull cords that are not closed loop;
- 2. Telephone cords;
- 3. Electrical/Extension cords attached to an object that would likely result in a severe injury if pulled;
- 4. Stacked chairs;
- 5. Employee(s) purse(s);
- 6. Diaper bags;
- 7. Television not securely anchored;
- 8. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall;
- 9. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child;
- 10. Chipping or peeling paint;
- 11. Emergency exits were blocked by the following furniture: [];
- 12. Other-knives, a vegetable peeler and a bag of match light charcoal.

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

## **Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment**

Rule: 5101:2-13-16 Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Requirements

Code: The program is required to post the fire and weather alert plan with a diagram.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined a fire and weather alert plan was was not posted upstairs as required by rule. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 10/10/2021

#### Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-13-16 Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Requirements Code: The program is required to complete and document the required drills.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the required drills were not completed for items in numbers 1 and 2 below:

- 1. Monthly fire drills
- 2. Monthly weather emergency drills (March through September)
- Quarterly emergency/lockdown drills.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Code: The program is required to post a current menu for the week.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program's weekly menu was not currently dated as required. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Code: The program is required to provide varied meals and snacks

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not serve varied meals and snacks in that the program served a repetitive meal and/or snack each day for the week. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 10/10/2021

Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-13-22 Meals and Snacks

Code: The program is required to provide the appropriate food groups with meals and snacks.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that snacks served at the program did not include foods from two of the four food groups. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance of the rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 10/10/2021

Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-13-16 Disaster Plan

Code: The program is required to have a completed written disaster plan.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the program's written disaster plan was missing the information in number 10 below:

#### Procedures:

- 1. The written disaster plan had not been completed
- 2. The plan was not provided to all child care staff and employees
- 3. Weather emergencies and natural disasters which include severe thunderstorms, tornadoes, flash flooding, major snowfall, blizzards, ice storms or earthquakes
- 4. Emergency outdoor and indoor lockdown or evacuation due to threats of violence which includes active shooter, bioterrorism or terrorism
- 5. Emergency or disaster evacuations due to hazardous materials and spills, gas leaks or bomb threats.
- 6. Outbreaks, epidemics or other infectious disease emergencies
- 7. Loss of power, water, or heat
- 8. Other threatening situations that may pose a health or safety hazard to the children in the program Details:
- 9. Shelter in place or evacuation, how the program will care for and account for the children until they can be reunited with the parent
- 10. Assisting infants and children with special needs and/or health conditions
- 11. Emergency contact information for parents and the program
- 12. Procedures for notifying and communicating with parents regarding the location of the children if evacuated
- 13. Procedures for communicating with parents during loss of communications, no phone or internet service available
- 14. The location of supplies and procedures for gathering necessary supplies for staff and children if required to shelter in place
- 15. What to do if a disaster occurs during the transport of children or when on a field trip or routine trip
- 16. Training of staff or reassignment of staff duties as appropriate
- 17. Updating the plan on a yearly basis
- 18. Contact with local emergency management officials
