<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, required staff/child ratios were not maintained for the same group on multiple occasions, as noted below:



The ratio determined for the combine PS - SA group was 1 Child Care Staff Member(s) for 18children. Additionally, a ratio of 1 Child Care Staff Member(s) for 14 children was determined for same group.

Additional staff members must be hired or current Child Care Staff Members must be rescheduled to maintain compliance. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that daily outdoor play was not provided for the older infants toddler, PS and SA groups. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the program's records, it was determined that completed JFS 01299 "Incident/Injury Report For Child Care" forms were not being kept on file at the program for at least one year, as required.
