Code: The program is required to have their license posted.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the provider's license was not posted. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Code: The program is required to have attendance records with the required information.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the attendance records did not include the required information listed in number 4 below:

- 1. The name of the child;
- 2. The birth date of the child;
- 3. The assigned group for the child;
- 4. The child's weekly schedule;

5. The time (hours and minutes) of each child's arrival and departure to the program, including transportation by the program.

The missing information must be added to the form used to maintain attendance records. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Equipment

Code: The program is required to use equipment according to manufacturer's guidelines.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the following equipment was not being used in accordance with the manufacturer's guidelines- baby was not buckled into the baby bouncer. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-13 Handwashing

Code: The program staff is required to have children wash their hands at the appropriate times as outlined in rule.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the hand washing requirements were not being followed by the children in care at the program, in that child arrived at program and did not wash hands upon arrival. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.



#### Corrective Action Plan Due: 10/20/2021

#### Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to protect children in care from items and conditions that threaten their health, safety, and well being.

Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following item which may threaten their health, safety, or well being as noted in the following number 12 below:

- 1. Open pull cords that are not closed loop;
- 2. Telephone cords;
- 3. Electrical/Extension cords attached to an object that would likely result in a severe injury if pulled;
- 4. Stacked chairs;
- 5. Employee(s) purse(s);
- 6. Diaper bags;
- 7. Television not securely anchored;
- 8. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall;
- 9. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child;
- 10. Chipping or peeling paint;
- 11. Emergency exits were blocked by the following furniture: [];
- 12. Other- sweeper outside on the outside deck.

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

#### Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-13-13 Clean Environment and Equipment Code: The program is required to have all required items in the restroom(s) and keep them sanitary.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that unsanitary conditions, as noted in the following number 5 below, were in the child care restroom:

- 1. There was no liquid soap.
- 2. There was no toilet tissue.
- 3. There were no individually assigned towels or disposable towels.
- 4. The toilet cleaning brush was accessible to the children.
- 5. The plunger was accessible to the children.
- 6. The toilet was not flushed.
- 7. The trash was not emptied from the day before.



8. There was a strong urine odor.

The restroom(s) must be kept sanitary at all times. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-11 Fall Zone

Code: The program is required to have a fall surface for outdoor equipment.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that while there was adequate fall surface material in the outdoor play space, proper distribution had not been maintained under and around equipment as required. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that fall surface material has been properly redistributed, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

# Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-13-16 First Aid Kit

Code: The program is required to meet the requirements for first aid kits.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not have a first aid kit onsite as required, that included all items listed in the appendix A of the rule. The kit were missing the items or the items were not replaced after use, when expired or damaged listed in numbers below: 1,4,15 and 16

- 1. One roll of hypoallergenic first-aid tape;
- 2. Individually wrapped sterile gauze
- squares in assorted sizes;
- 3. Sterile adhesive bandages in assorted sizes;
- 4.Tweezers;
- 5. Gauze rolled bandage;
- 6. Triangular bandage;
- 7. Rounded end scissors;

8. Tooth preservation system or fresh chilled liquid milk in which to transport a lost permanent tooth, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where milk is stored if a tooth preservation system is not part of the first aid kit (for programs serving school age children only);

- 9. A working digital thermometer;
- 10. Disposable non-latex gloves;
- 11. A working flashlight;

12. An instant cold pack that has not been activated or ice, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where the ice is stored if an instant cold pack is not part of the first aid kit;



13. Sealable leak-proof plastic bags in assorted sizes or double bagged plastic bags that can be securely tied for materials soiled with blood or bodily fluids;

14. Pocket mask or face shield, appropriate; for all ages of children in care, for cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) administration;

15. Soap or waterless sanitizer (field trip or transporting away from the program only);

16. Bottled water (field trip or transporting away from the program only).

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 10/20/2021

Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-13-16 Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Requirements Code: The program is required to complete and document the required drills.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the required drills were not completed for item number 3 below:

- 1. Monthly fire drills
- 2. Monthly weather emergency drills (March through September)
- 3. Quarterly emergency/lockdown drills.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

# Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-13-23 Infant Bottle and Food Preparation

Code: The program is required to retain and update infant feeding instructions.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that written instructions for feeding the infants noted on the Children Record Review form were not on file, as required by this rule. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

# Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-13-20 Crib and Playpen Requirements Code: The program is required to remove objects from cribs/playpens that could block the child.



Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a child had been place in a crib or playpen with the following number 4 below which could obstruct a provider or child care staff member's view of the infant:

1. Busy box or other toy attached to the side of the crib or playpen.

2. A blanket hanging over the side of the crib or playpen.

3. Stuffed animal that is not large/soft enough that it could conform to the shape of the child's face.

4. Other-adult sized pillow in pack in play with infant

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-15 JFS 01234 'Child Enrollment and Health Information' Code: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information for Child Care" on file on the premises for each child.

Findings: In review of the children's records, it was determined that information had not been secured from the parent/guardian on the JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information For Child Care", as required, for the items in numbers 5,9,10 and 12

- 1. No enrollment form was completed for at least one child
- 2. The current JFS 01234 was not completed for at least one child
- 3. Complete parent information
- 4. Complete emergency contact information
- 5. Complete physician information
- 6. Information regarding the parent list
- 7. Health information
