Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-13-18 Attendance

Code: The program is required to maintain attendance records.



Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not meet the requirements for keeping an attendance record as listed in number 3 below:

- 1. No attendance record was being maintained.
- 2. The attendance record was not being consistently completed.
- 3. The original attendance documentation was not kept at the program for a period of one year.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 06/01/2023

Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-13-20 Sleep and Nap Requirements Code: The program is required to use mats appropriately for napping.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that all cots and/or mats did not meet the dimensions as noted in number 4 below:

- 1. The cot must stand at least 3" and no more than 18" off the floor.
- 2. The cot must be at least 36" in length and as long as the child is tall.
- 3. The mat must be at least 1" thick and as wide and long as the child assigned.
- 4. The mats were not assigned.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 06/01/2023

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-13-13 Handwashing

Code: The program staff is required to have children wash their hands at the appropriate times as outlined in rule.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the handwashing requirements were not being followed by the children in care at the program, the child's hands were not washed after diaper change. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 06/01/2023



Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment

Rule: 5101:2-13-16 Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan Code: The program is required to post the completed JFS 01201 "Dental First Aid" and implement as required by rule.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the JFS 01201 "Dental First Aid" was not completed. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 06/01/2023

Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment

Rule: 5101:2-13-17 Materials and Equipment

Code: The program is required to have sufficient equipment and materials.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that equipment and materials in the following categories were not provided in sufficient quantities, as required by the rule: 6

- 1. Art supplies (excludes infants);
- 2. Manipulative materials and equipment;
- 3. Blocks;
- 4. Science-nature equipment (excludes infants);
- 5. Language arts and auditory materials and equipment;
- 6. Pretend or dramatic play materials;
- 7. Music equipment;
- 8. Transportation materials and equipment;
- 9. Gross motor equipment;
- 10. Sensory motor equipment.

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 06/01/2023

Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-13-22 Fluid Milk

Code: The program is to ensure that children are served age-appropriate fluid milk.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not have the type of milk on-site to ensure that all children were served age-appropriate fluid milk requirements. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.



Corrective Action Plan Due: 06/01/2023

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-13-23 Infant Daily Care

Code: The program staff is required to provide appropriate infant daily care.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program's infant daily care did not meet the requirements of this rule as noted in number 3 below:

1. Infants could not safely and comfortably sit, crawl, toddle, or walk and play according to the infant's stage of development;

2. Infants were not removed from the crib, swing, infant seat, exercise seat or other equipment throughout the day for individual attention;

3. Each non-crawling infant was not provided the opportunity for tummy time each day;

4. Other [].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 06/01/2023

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-13-23 Diapering

Code: The program staff is required to have adequate supplies for diapering available.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the required supplies were not available for diaper changing as noted in the following number 1 below:

1. There was no disposable separation material;

2. There was no germicidal solution for sanitizing;

- 3. There were no plastic containers or bags for the storage of soiled clothing;
- 4. There was no clean supply of diapers;
- 5. There was no extra change of clothing;
- 6. Other [].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 08 Staff Files



Rule: 5101:2-13-08 Employee Requirements

Code: The program is required to obtain completed medical statements for all program staff.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a completed medical examination statement for the employee listed on the Employee Record Chart was not on file, as required by this rule. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the completed medical statement with all required information, to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-07 Provider Responsibilities Code: The provider is required to have hours of availability to meet with parents posted in a noticeable place.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the provider did not have hours of availability to meet with parents a noticeable location. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 06/01/2023

Domain: 09 Children's Files

Rule: 5101:2-13-15 Child Medical and Enrollment Records Code: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information for Child Care" on file on the premises for each child.

Findings: In review of the children's records, it was determined that information had not been secured from the parent/guardian on the JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information For Child Care", as required, for the items in numbers 8, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 below:

- 1. No enrollment form was completed for at least one child
- 2. The current JFS 01234 was not completed for at least one child
- 3. Complete child information
- 4. Complete parent information
- 5. Complete emergency contact information
- 6. Complete physician information
- 7. Information regarding the parent list
- 8. Health information
- 9. Additional information for all boxes checked "yes"
- 10. Emergency transportation information
- 11. Parent/guardian's signature
- 12. Diapering Statement
- 13. Acknowledgement of Policies and Procedures



14. Enrollment form for at least one child was not updated by either the parent or the administrator 15. Enrollment form for at least one child was not signed by the administrator

Corrective Action Plan Due: 06/01/2023

Domain: 09 Children's Files

Rule: 5101:2-13-15 Child Medical and Enrollment Records Code: The program is required to have a completed medical on file for each child.

Findings: In review of of the children's records, it was determined that completed medical statements were not on file, as required, for children listed on the JFS Children's Record Review For Child Care as indicated in number 1 below

- 1. No medical was on file for at least one child
- 2. Medical(s) on file was not updated every 13 months
- 3. Medical(s) were missing child's name and date of birth
- 4. Medical(s) were missing the date of the medical examination
- 5. The date of the exam was more than 13 months prior to the date the form was signed

6. Medical(s) were missing a statement that the child has been examined and is in suitable condition for participation in group care

7. Medical(s) were missing the signature, business address and telephone number of the physician, physician's assistant(PA), advance practice nurse (APN) or certified

- nurse practitioner (CNP) who examined the child
- 8. Medical(s) were missing a record of immunizations the child has had specifying month, day and year

9. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the physician, PA, APN, or CNP that the child has been immunized or is in the process of being immunized against the diseases

10. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the child's parent or guardian that he or she has declined to have the child immunized against the disease for reasons of

conscience, including religious convictions
