### Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5180:2-13-13 Handwashing

Code: The program staff and residents are required to wash their hands at the appropriate times as outlined in

rule.



Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the handwashing requirements were not being followed by the provider, program staff, residents, or a child in that when the children came from outdoor play from the backyard playing, the children and provider didn't wash their hands. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5180:2-13-11 Outdoor Equipment

Code: The program is required to provide equipment that does not pose a safety risk and must follow the manufacturer's guidelines for assembling, installing and using the equipment.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that outdoor play equipment was unsafe as noted in the number 14 below:

- 1. There was rust exposed.
- 2. There was protruding bolts.
- 3. There were cracks.
- 4. There were holes.
- 5. There was splintering wood.
- 6. There were sharp edges or points.
- 7. There were lead hazards.
- 8. There were toxic substances.
- 9. There were tripping hazards.
- 10. The sandbox was not covered when the program was closed or during non-daylight hours.
- 11. Outdoor equipment, [ ], was not developmentally appropriate.
- 12. Outdoor equipment, [ ], was placed in the main traffic pattern.
- 13. Outdoor play equipment, [ ], was positioned too closely together, posing a risk of injury if a child were to fall from one piece of equipment into another.
- 14. Outdoor equipment gate for the trampoline, was not securely anchored but did not present a risk of imminent

danger of the structure collapsing when children are using the equipment

- 15. Outdoor equipment, [ ], was 30 inches or more from the ground and did not have a protective barrier that would prevent a child from falling off this piece of equipment.
- 16. The manufacturer's guidelines for assembly and installation were not followed for the [ ].

Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space



Rule: 5180:2-13-11 Fall Zone

Code: The program is required to use fall surface material according to manufacturer's guidelines and provide fall zones around equipment to prevent injury if a child were to fall.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the fall zone under and around equipment designated for climbing, swinging, balancing and sliding did not meet the requirements as noted in number(s) 3 below:

- 1. The fall surface material had not been properly distributed, turned over or raked as needed.
- 2. The fall surface material was not being used according to manufacturer's guidelines for its use as a fall surface.
- 3. Other Provider needs more mulch around the outdoor equipment.

The program is required to provide adequate fall zones under and around outdoor play equipment at all times. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### **Domain: 06 Program Information**

Rule: 5180:2-13-14 Requirements for Field and Routine Trips

Code: The program is required to obtain written parental permission before leaving the premises and retain the forms for at least one year from the date of the trip. Routine trip permission forms must be updated annually.

Findings: In review of the program's records, it was determined that requirements for written permission from the parent/guardian for a field trip or routine trip were not met as listed in number 4 below:

- 1. Written parental permission was not secured for field trips and/or routine trips off the premises.
- 2. The written permission was missing the child's name.
- 3. The written permission was missing the date(s) of the trip(s) (field trips only).
- 4. The written permission was missing the destination(s) of the trip(s).
- 5. The written permission was missing the departure and return time(s) of the trip(s) (field trips only).
- 6. The written permission was missing the signature of the parent.
- 7. The written permission was missing the date on which the permission was signed.
- 8. The written permission was missing a statement notifying parents how their child will be transported.
- 9. Permission forms for routine trips were not being updated annually.
- 10. Written parental permission forms for field trips and/or routine trips were not being maintained on file for at least one year from the date of the trip.

Rule: 5180:2-13-14 Vehicle Inspections

Code: The program is required to complete and document weekly vehicle inspections.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program had not performed/documented weekly inspections of vehicles used for transporting children. The weekly inspection needs to include the following: 1,2,3,4,5,6 below.

- 1. A visual inspection of the tires for wear and tire pressure;
- 2. A visual inspection of headlights, taillights, signals, mirrors, wiper blades, and dash gauges;
- 3. An inspection for properly functioning child and driver restraints;
- 4. An inspection for properly functioning doors and windows;
- 5. An inspection for, and cleaning of, debris from the inside of the vehicle;
- 6. Other -Need to be completed weekly

Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-13-15 Child Medical and Enrollment Records

Code: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information for Child Care" on file on the premises for each child.

Findings: In review of the children's records, it was determined that information had not been secured from the parent/guardian on the JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information For Child Care", as required, for the items in number 6, 8 below:

- 1. No enrollment form was completed for at least one child
- 2. The current JFS 01234 was not completed for at least one child
- 3. Complete child information
- 4. Complete parent information
- 5. Complete emergency contact information
- 6. Complete physician information
- 7. Information regarding the parent list
- 8. Health information
- 9. Additional information for all boxes checked "yes"

- 13. Acknowledgement of Policies and Procedures
- 14. Enrollment form for at least one child was not updated by either the parent or the administrator
