Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the administrator, child care staff, and/or employees of the program did not protect or remove children from a situation and/or person determined to be unsafe or inappropriate as noted in number 2 below:

1. Verbal argument involving adults.
2. Staff members allowed a child to do something unsafe, in that a child was not removed from the area where children were actively swinging on the playground, resulting in a minor injury.
3. Staff member did something unsafe.
4. Children were exposed to inappropriate media.
5. Other.

While the program did not protect the child from an unsafe or inappropriate situation, it was determined the situation would not or did not result in a serious incident or serious injury to a child. All program employees must take actions to protect children in care. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
