Complaint Allegations

Code: The program staff is required to protect or remove a child from a situation and/or person that are determined to be unsafe or inappropriate.

Allegation: A child was not removed from an unsafe situation on the playground.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the administrator, child care staff, and/or employees of the program did not protect or remove children from a situation and/or person determined to be unsafe or inappropriate as noted in number 2 below:

- 1. Verbal argument involving adults.
- 2. Staff members allowed a child to do something unsafe, in that a child was not removed from the area where children were actively swinging on the playground, resulting in a minor injury.
- 3. Staff member did something unsafe.
- 4. Children were exposed to inappropriate media.
- 5. Other.

While the program did not protect the child from an unsafe or inappropriate situation, it was determined the situation would not or did not result in a serious incident or serious injury to a child. All program employees must take actions to protect children in care. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
