Rule: 5101:2-12-04 Fire Inspection

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all spaces used for child care inspected by the fire department or the state fire marshal's office prior to serving children. If violations are noted during the inspection, the program is required to have all violations corrected and have the program reinspected to obtain a completed fire form.
