Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a child care staff member used a discipline technique to guide or discipline a child that was not developmentally appropriate, consistent, or occurred at the time of the incident. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Code: The program is required to use straps on equipment that is manufactured with straps.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined/observed through video that the following equipment was not used according to manufacturer's guidelines as noted in number 2 below:

- 1. The straps were missing on the [].
- 2. The straps were attached, but were not used with the table with seats as it was observed a child was removed without any belt being unsnapped as well as a child was placed in a seat and straps were not secured.
- 3. The straps were attached and were used, but were not used in a safe manner.
- 4. Manufacturer's guidelines for the [] were not followed in that [].
