Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to refrain from using and storing potentially hazardous items, toxic substances, and outdoor machinery around children.

Findings: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous item or toxic substance was used or stored where children present had access to it. Drano, alcohol spray, and paint cans were determined to be accessible to children. Please move these three items or make inaccessible to children.

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the potentially hazardous substance or item is no longer accessible to children and/or children will not be outside when machinery is in use and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to protect children from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined tools were accessible in the kitchen. Both a hammer and a wrench were found in kitchen drawers.

Any hazardous equipment must be removed, replaced, or repaired and any hazardous condition must be corrected and must be made inaccessible to children. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the item or condition has been removed and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Low Risk Non-Compliances

Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-13-18 Attendance

Code: The program is required to maintain a record of the arrival and departure of each child. The program is also required to retain the original attendance record at the program for a period of one year.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the programs attendance was not being documented upon arrival.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 11/23/2024

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well being. During the inspection, it was determined that outlet covers did not have surge protectors or covers in the bathroom and hallway.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-13-16 Emergency Preparedness and Response Plan

Code: The program is required to have a completed emergency preparedness and response plan.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the program's written emergency preparedness and response plan was not on file. Form is JFS 1251, this is the new disaster plan.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes the missing information, if applicable, to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-22 Meals and Snacks

Code: The program is required to safely store food.

Findings: During this inspection, it was determined the refrigerator did not maintain a temperature of 40 degrees Fahrenheit or below

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-16 First Aid Kit/Standard Precautions

Code: The program is required to meet the requirements for first aid kits.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the first aid kit was missing rolled gauze.

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 06 Program Information

Rule: 5101:2-13-14 Requirements for Field and Routine Trips

Code: The program is required to obtain written parental permission before leaving the premises and retain the forms for at least one year from the date of the trip. Routine trip permission forms must be updated annually.

Findings: In review of the program's records, it was determined that routine trip forms were not on file for all children in care. For the children that did have the form, the form was incomplete- it was missing a destination and mode of travel on the form.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 11/23/2024

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-13-23 Infant Bottle and Food Preparation

Code: The program is required to retain and update infant feeding instructions.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that written instructions for feeding the infants noted on the Children Record Review form were not on file for children under 18 months, as required by this rule. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 11/23/2024

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-13-23 Infant Daily Care

Code: The program is required to provide a daily written record for each infant in care to the parents when picking up the infant each day.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the written record used to document infant routines and activities was not on file.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5101:2-13-07 Staff Records

Code: The provider is required to maintain current employee, child care staff members and resident records in the Ohio Professional Registry.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that Jamar was missing a position and position date on his OCCRA account.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 11/23/2024

Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5101:2-13-10 Health Training

Code: The program is required to meet the health training requirements.

Findings: In review of records, it was determined the provider did not have current valid documentation for communicable disease and child abuse training.

Correct the violation and submit the documentation of current certification with the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 11/23/2024

Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5101:2-13-10 Professional Development

Code: The program staff is required to complete at least six clock hours of training annually.

Findings: In review of records, it was determined the provider had not completed the 6 required professional development hours annually. Please take these in OCCRA, hours will be verified as completed before this correction is approved.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-07 Provider Responsibilities

Code: The provider is required to maintain the required liability insurance or have a completed JFS 01933 "Liability Insurance Statement for Family Child Care Providers" on file for each child in care.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the provider did not have a completed JFS 01933 "Liability Insurance Statement for Family Child Care Providers" completed for each child in care. Correct the violation and submit proof of insurance with the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 11/23/2024

Domain: 09 Children's Files

Rule: 5101:2-13-15 Child Medical and Enrollment Records

Code: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information for Child Care" on file on the premises for each child.

Findings: In review of the children's records, it was determined the JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information For Child Care", was missing for some children and other children needed the form updated on the last page by parent and provider.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 11/23/2024

Domain: 09 Children's Files

Rule: 5101:2-13-15 Child Medical and Enrollment Records

Code: The program is required to have a completed medical on file for each child.

Findings: In review of of the children's records, it was determined that completed medical statements were not on file, as required, for all children under age 5. A completed JFS 1305 medical statement and vaccination records must be kept on file.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 10 Written Policies & Procedures

Rule: 5101:2-13 Written Policies and Procedures

Code: The provider is required to create, maintain, and implement the policies and procedures outlined in appendix C and D of this rule.

Findings: It was determined, the provider had not updated the programs handbook or written information for parents. The form number for this is JFS 1312.
