Rule: 5101:2-12-04 Fire Inspection

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all spaces used for child care inspected by the fire department or the state fire marshal's office prior to serving children. The program is required to obtain a fire inspection without any uncorrected violations within 12 months from the date of the last fire inspection. If violations are noted



during the inspection, the program is required to have all violations corrected and have the program reinspected to obtain a completed fire form.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not meet the requirements for fire inspection as noted in number 2 below:

- 1. The program did not have documentation on file for a fire inspection without any uncorrected violations within 12 months from the date of the last fire inspection and the request for the new inspection was not made at least 30 days prior to the expiration of the previous fire inspection.
- 2. The documentation for the most recent fire inspection contained violations that had not been corrected.

In review of the children's records, it was determined that the required written information was either not on file, implemented or followed, for at least one child indicated on the Children Records Review, as noted in number(s) 13 and 25 below:

- 14. Directions for action to be taken if expected result of medication or medical food does not occur were missing.
- 15. Instructions regarding emergency evacuation, if applicable, were missing.
- 16. Dated signature of parent was missing.
- 17. Dated signature of certified professional who trained the program staff was missing, if parent was not the trainer.
- 18. Printed name(s)/Dated signature(s) of child care staff member(s) trained to perform the procedure were missing.
- 19. Dated signature(s) of administrator was missing.
- 20. Name of any applicable medication was missing.
- 21. Date medication was administered was missing.
- 22. Time medication was administered was missing.
- 23. Dosage administered was missing.
- 24. Signature of staff member who administered the medication was missing.
- 25. Medication listed in the procedures to follow was not onsite available to administer as instructed and alternate instructions for this situation were not included on the plan.
- 26. The plan was not implemented.
- 27. The plan was not able to be implemented due to conflicting information.
- 28. The plan was not followed.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that equipment and materials in the following categories 1 were not provided in sufficient quantities for children in the Two's, Toddler, and Older Toddler classrooms; and in the following categories 3 were not provided in sufficient quantities for children in the Older Toddler classroom, as required by the rule:

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that the medical statements for those employees listed on the Employee Record Chart did not include the required information listed below in number(s) 1, 3b, 3c, and 4a.

- 1. Date of examination;
- 2. Signature, business address, and telephone number of the licensed physician, physician assistant, advanced practice nurse, certified midwife, or certified nurse practitioner who completed the examination;
- 3. A statement that verifies that the employee is:
- a. Physically fit for employment in a program caring for children;
- b. Immunized against Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap);
- c. Immunized against Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR);
- 4. Tuberculosis (TB) screening/test
- a. Documentation of the screening process to determine if the employee resided in a country identified by the World Health Organization as having a high burden of TB and arrived in the United States within the five years preceding the date of application for employment;
- b. Results of a TB test for employees meeting both criteria in 4a;
- c. Results of additional testing for employees with a positive TB test;
- d. Written statement, signed by a representative of the TB control unit, that the employee's TB is no longer infectious or the individual is receiving a TB treatment regimen for employees with a positive TB test.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the completed employee medical statement, or TB results/documentation, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Code</u>: The program staff medicals are required to be completed and on file at the program.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined a completed medical examination statement for the employee(s) listed on the Employee Record Chart was not on file, as required by this rule. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the completed employee medical statement, to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

- 4. The administrator had not assigned at least one employee or child care staff member to the program's organization dashboard.
- 5. At least one individual's schedule was not current.
- 6. At least one individual's position or role did not include an applicable group assignment.
- 7. At least one individual's employment had not been end dated.

- 9. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the physician, PA, APN, or CNP that the child has been immunized or is in the process of being immunized against the diseases

- 10. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the child's parent or guardian that he or she has declined to have the child immunized against the disease for reasons of conscience, including religious convictions

- 7. Outbreaks, epidemics or other infectious disease emergencies
- 8. Loss of power, water, or heat
- 9. Other threatening situations that may pose a health or safety hazard to the children in the program Details:
- 10. Shelter in place or evacuation, how the program will care for and account for the children until they can be reunited with the parent
- 11. Assisting infants and children with special needs and/or health conditions
- 12. Emergency contact information for parents and the program
- 13. Procedures for notifying and communicating with parents regarding the location of the children if evacuated
- 14. Procedures for communicating with parents during loss of communications, no phone or internet service available
- 15. The location of supplies and procedures for gathering necessary supplies for staff and children if required to shelter in place
- 16. What to do if a disaster occurs during the transport of children or when on a field trip or routine trip
- 17. Making the plan available to all child care staff members and employees
- 18. Training of staff or reassignment of staff duties as appropriate
- 19. Updating the plan on a yearly basis
- 20. Contact with local emergency management officials

Make the necessary revisions to the disaster plan. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes the revised information, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Code</u>: The program's policies and procedures are required to include all topics outlined in rule.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program's written policies and procedures provided to the parents/guardians and employees was missing item number(s) 15, 23, and 29 below:

- 1. Program name, address, email address and telephone number.
- 2. Description of the program's program philosophy.
- 3. Days and hours of operation, scheduled closings and basic daily schedule.
- 4. Staff/child ratios and group size.
- 5. Opportunities for parent involvement in program activities.

- 21. Transportation for fieldtrips, routine trips (if applicable) and emergencies, including if the center will provide child care services to children whose parents refuse to grant consent for transportation to the source of emergency treatment.
- 22. Water activities/swimming.
- 23. Infant care, if applicable, including feeding, frequency of diaper checks and information about daily activities.
