Code: The program staff is required to meet each child's basic, developmental, behavioral and special needs.

Allegation: Children's basic needs are not being met,

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that child-care staff did not meet the basic needs of a child as noted in number 10 below:

1. Assisting children with toileting
2. Assisting children with handwashing
3. Assisting children with basic hygiene
4. Responding appropriately to a child in distress
5. Assisting a child wiping his/her nose
6. Washing a child's face
7. Assisting a child in tying his/her shoes
8. Assisting a child in changing his/her clothes when needed
9. A child's developmental needs were not met
10. Children's behavioral needs were not met
11. Parental preferences, that were not in conflict with a licensing rule, were not followed

Code: The program is required to provide a clean restroom with the appropriate materials available.

Allegation: The restrooms are unclean.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that unsanitary conditions, as noted in number(s) 6 and 9 below, were in the boys and girl's preschool side restrooms:

1. There was no liquid soap.
2. There was no toilet paper.
3. There were no paper towels.
4. The toilet cleaning brush was accessible to the children.

5. The plunger was accessible to the children.
6. The toilet(s) were not flushed.
7. The trash was not emptied from the day before.
8. There was a strong urine odor.
9. Other: human waste on seat and side of toilet in boy's bathroom/preschool side.

The restroom(s) must be kept sanitary at all times. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.

Domain:07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5180:2-12-20 Cribs

Code: The program is required to provide enough cribs for all infants in attendance who require a crib.

Allegation: There are an inadequate number of cribs.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program had 9 of cribs and needed 13. A crib must be provided for all infants in attendance, unless the infant meets the criteria for sleeping on a cot or mat and a cot or mat is used. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.
