The ratio determined for the infant through preschool group was 2 Child Care Staff Member(s) for 21 children. Additionally, a ratio of 1 Child Care Staff Member(s) for 20 children was determined for the infant through preschool group.

Additional staff members must be hired or current Child Care Staff Members must be rescheduled to maintain compliance. Provide staff training. Submit the program’s corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
