<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that a space heater which had not been approved by a fire official was in use in the area identified in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. The administrator's office.
- 2. A classroom.
- 3. The break room.
- 4. Several classrooms.

- 5. The hallway.
- 6. The entry way.

The use of this space heater must be discontinued until approval for its use has been obtained. <u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that child-care staff did not meet the basic needs of a child as noted in number(s) 5 below:

- 1. Assisting children with toileting
- Assisting children with handwashing
- 3. Assisting children with basic hygiene
- 4. Responding appropriately to a child in distress
- 5. Assisting a child wiping his/her nose (infant & toddler rooms).
- 6. Washing a child's face
- 7. Assisting a child in tying his/her shoes
- 8. Assisting a child in changing his/her clothes when needed
- 9. A child's developmental needs were not met
- 10. A child's behavioral needs were not met
- 11. Parental preferences, that were not in conflict with a licensing rule, were not followed

Code: The program is required to provide a sturdy platform for children if the sink or toilet are too high.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the platform for the sink/toilet in the toddler & preschool bathrooms was unsafe for children as noted in number(s) 3 below.

- 1. No platform was provided.
- 2. The platform was not sturdy.
- 3. The platform posed a safety hazard in that there was no gripping to prevent the stool from sliding when in use.

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to follow the cleaning schedule for equipment.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the children's individual blankets and belongings were stored in an unsanitary manner in both the toddler & preschool rooms in that blankets, coats & bookbags were touching one another and some items were stored on the cots in the toddler room. Children's belongings need to be stored in a sanitary manner to prevent the spread of germs. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to store chemicals in a place that is inaccessible to children.



<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous substance, which was determined to not present a serious risk to a child, was accessible to children as noted in number(s) 9 below:

- 3. Fish food;

- 1. Open pull cords that are not closed loop.
- 2. Telephone cords.
- 3. Electrical/extension cords attached to an object that would not likely result in a severe injury if pulled.
- 4. Stacked chairs.
- 5. Employee(s) purse(s).
- 6. Diaper bags.
- 7. Television not securely anchored.
- 8. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.
- 9. Smoke detector needing batteries replaced.
- 10. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child.

- 11. Emergency exits were blocked by the following classroom furniture: stacked chairs were in front of an emergency exit in the older toddler classroom.
- 12. Other: push pins (preschool room teachers desk drawer).

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to post and implement the JFS 01242 "Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan" when necessary.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the requirements for the JFS 01242 "Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan for Child Care" were not followed as noted in number(s) 5 below:

- 1. The plan was not posted in each classroom.
- 2. The plan was not posted in other spaces used by children.
- 3. The name, address and telephone number of the program were not complete.
- 4. The location of first aid kit, fire extinguishers and fire alarm system, fire alarm pull stations and electrical circuit box were not complete.
- 5. The telephone number for emergency squad, fire department, hospital, poison control program, public children services agency, local health department, local emergency management agency, and police department were not complete- EMS number was missing.
- 6. Location of children's records was not complete.
- 7. Emergency information including any medications or supplies needed in the event of an evacuation was not complete.
- 8. The current version of the prescribed form was not used.
- 9. The plan was not implemented when necessary in that [].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Code: The program is required to have a completed medical on file at the program for each child enrolled.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of 25% of the children's records, it was determined that completed medical statements were not on file, as required, for children listed on the JFS Children's Record Review For Child Care as indicated in number(s) 7,8 below:

- 1. No medical was on file for at least one child
- 2. Medical(s) on file was not updated every 13 months
- 3. Medical(s) were missing child's name and date of birth
- 4. Medical(s) were missing the date of the medical examination
- 5. The date of the exam was more than 13 months prior to the date the form was signed.
- 6. Medical(s) were missing a statement that the child has been examined and is in suitable condition for participation in group care
- 7. Medical(s) were missing the signature, business address and telephone number of the physician, physician's assistant(PA), advance practice nurse (APN) or certified nurse practitioner (CNP) who examined the child
- 8. Medical(s) were missing a record of immunizations the child has had specifying month, day and year
- 9. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the physician, PA, APN, or CNP that the child has been immunized or is in the process of being immunized against the diseases
- required by division 5104.014 of the Revised Code and found in appendix A to this rule
- 10. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the child's parent or guardian that he or she has declined to have the child immunized against the disease for reasons of conscience, including religious convictions
