<u>Code</u>: The program is required to store chemicals and machinery in a place that is inaccessible to children. The program is required to provide an outdoor play area away from machinery in operation.

- 15. Immediate access to a knife.

- 17. Child was unbuckled from high-chair and left standing while staff cleaned.

Any hazardous equipment must be removed, replaced, or repaired and any hazardous condition must be corrected and must be made inaccessible to children. Provide staff training. - 3. Medical(s) were missing child's name and date of birth
