**Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment**

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to provide ventilation if the indoor temperature exceeds 85 degrees Fahrenheit.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the following areas being used for child care were not ventilated appropriately in that the smell of cigar smoke was strong in the home. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 12/28/2022

**Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment**

Rule: 5101:2-13-13 Smoke Free

Code: The program is required to provide notification to parents if smoking occurs on the premises outside of operating hours.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that smoking had occurred in the program building during hours the program was not in operation; however, parents had not been given written notice of this. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 12/28/2022

**Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment**

Rule: 5101:2-13-13 Smoke Free

Code: The program is required to provide a smoke free environment during operating hours.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not provide a smoke free environment for children during the hours of child care in that the area where smoking takes place is not far removed from the childcare area where smoke cannot be inhaled by the children which is unavoidable if smoking going through the upstairs vents to the downstairs childcare area. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
