Complaint Allegations

Code: The program is required to maintain the appropriate staff to child ratio for each group served.

Allegation: The complainant alleged that the center is out of ratio

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that required staff/child ratios were not maintained for the preschool aged classrooms on multiple occasions, as noted below:

During the complaint interviews, multiple child care staff members reported that ratios are not consistently maintained in the preschool aged classrooms due to call offs and lack of staff.

Additional staff members must be hired or current Child Care Staff Members must be rescheduled to maintain compliance. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
