Domain:02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5180:2-12-13 Handwashing Requirements

Code: The program is required to have all staff and children wash their hands as outlined in rule.

Allegation: The program does not have all staff and children wash their hands as outlined in rule.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that handwashing requirements were not followed as listed in number(s) 4,5 below, as required in rule.

1. At least one staff/child did not wash their hands upon arrival for the day.
2. At least one staff/child did not wash their hands prior to departure.
3. At least one staff did not wash their hands upon entry into a classroom.
4. At least one staff/child did not wash their hands after toileting or assisting a child with toileting. (Toddler Room)
5. At least one staff/child did not wash their hands after each diaper change or pull-up change. (Infant and Toddler Room)
6. At least one staff did not wash their hands after contact with bodily fluids or cleaning up spills or objects contaminated with bodily fluids.
7. At least one child did not wash their hands after contact with bodily fluids.
8. At least one child did not wash their hands after returning inside after outdoor play.
9. At least one staff did not wash their hands after cleaning or sanitizing or using any chemical products.
10. At least one staff/child did not wash their hands after handling pets, pet cages or other pet objects that have come in contact with the pet.
11. At least one staff did not wash their hands before eating, serving or preparing food or bottles or feeding a child.
12. At least one child did not wash their hands before eating or assisting with food preparation.
13. At least one staff did not wash their hands before and after completing a medical procedure or administering medication.
14. At least one child did not wash their hands after water activities.
15. At least one staff/child did not wash their hands when visibly soiled (must use soap and water).

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the required drills were not completed for item number(s) 1,2,3 below:

1. Monthly fire drills.
2. Monthly weather emergency drills (March through September).
3. Emergency/lockdown drills in each quarter of the calendar year.

Rule: 5180:2-12-23 Diapering and Toilet Training

Code: The program staff is required to use and discard a separation material between each diaper change.

Allegation: The program staff does not use and discard a separation material between each diaper change.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the staff did not [use a/discard] separation material between each diaper change, as required by the rule, at the diaper changing station. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule. (Toddler Room)

Rule: 5180:2-12-23 Infant Daily Care

Code: The program staff is required to hold infants or have the infant sitting up while feeding. The program staff may not place an infant in a crib with a bottle.

Allegation: The program staff does not hold infants or have the infant sitting up while feeding.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not meet the requirements for bottle feeding as noted in number(s) 3 below:

1. A bottle was propped for an infant feeding.
2. An infant was placed in a crib with a bottle.
3. An infant was not held or fed sitting up for bottle feedings.

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-12-20 Cribs

Code: The program is required to space cribs two feet apart when in use.

Allegation: The program does not space cribs two feet apart when in use.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that cribs were not two feet apart when in use, as required by this rule. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.
