Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5180:2-13-20 Crib and Playpen Requirements

Code: The program is required to refrain from using a crib that is assigned to a child for storage.

Allegation: Allegation: Playpens had blankets and was being used for storage.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a crib/playpen, assigned to a child, was used for storage. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

#### Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5180:2-13-20 Crib and Playpen Requirements

Code: The program staff is required to place infants in a crib or playpen with no strangulation hazards.

Allegation: Allegation: Playpens had blankets and was being used for storage.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that an infant was placed in a crib with the following suffocation or strangulation hazard a blanket was in the playpen. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Risk Level: Moderate

Corrective Action Plan Due: 09/13/2025

#### Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5180:2-13-07 Provider Responsibilities

Code: The provider is required to reside at the licensed location, not have additional activities or employment during the program's operating hours, be on-site at the program for at least 75 percent of the program's operating hours, and have hours of availability posted in a noticeable place.

Allegation: Allegation: Provider was working as a driver for the center they own during the hours of their in home daycare.

Determination: Substantiated



Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the provider was not meeting the following requirements as noted in number 2 below:

- 1. The provider no longer resides at the licensed location.
- 2. The licensed provider has additional activities/employment during operating hours, in that the provider was working as a driver for the center they own.
- 3. The provider was not on-site for 75 percent of the program's operating hours as required by this rule.
- 4. The provider did not have hours of availability to meet with parents a noticeable location.

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.
