### Complaint Allegations

Rule: 5101:2-12-18 Ratio

Code: The program is required to maintain the appropriate staff to child ratio for each group served.

Allegation: The program was out of ratio when one child care staff member was caring for 12 children, and the group included infants and toddlers.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, a ratio of 1 child care staff member(s) for 12 children was determined to have occurred for the combined infant, toddler, preschool, and school age groups when the situation in number(s) 10 and 11 below occurred:

1. A child care staff member stepped out of the room.
2. A child care staff member had not arrived at work on time.
3. Children were present who were not scheduled to be there.
4. A child care staff member was unable to work.
5. A child was injured in that group.
6. A child arrived in the group before a second staff member was scheduled to arrive with the group.
7. Two groups were combined, and the program did not follow the ratio for the youngest child in the group.
8. A child was transitioning to the next older age group, and the program did not follow the ratio for the youngest child in the group.
9. Ratio was doubled for more than two hours while children were napping.
10. Ratio was doubled while children were napping for a group that included at least one infant.
11. Ratio was doubled while children were napping and there were not enough staff members in the building to meet staff/child ratio.
12. Ratio was doubled in the school age group to allow access to the program, however, the program does not serve only school age children.
13. Both child care staff members did not have a working communication device when one staff member left the group to allow access to the school age only program.
14. The child care staff member did not return to the group after allowing access to the school age only program.

Additional child care staff members must be hired or current child care staff members must be rescheduled to maintain compliance. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not meet the rule requirement as noted in number(s) 1 below:

1. The program did not have a second employee or Child Care Staff Member present when required, in that on the day of the complaint allegation, it was determined that there was only one staff member present in the child care facility when 12 children were present.
2. The program was using a second Child Care Staff Member who was not able to meet this criteria as defined in the rule.
