Code: The program is required to be kept clean to prevent an infestation of insects or rodents.

Allegation: There are bed bugs present in the building.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was acknowledged that bed bugs have recently been found in several classrooms. A professional company was hired to treat the building (on the weekend). Since that treatment only a couple of the bugs have been found. The company will conduct follow up treatments if needed. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

Code: The program is required to provide a clean and healthy environment.

Allegation: The program is not cleaned or sanitized as required.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: It was stated that the program is cleaned daily. However, during the inspection, there was a strong odor (possibly urine) in the School Age Room, PreK Room and the hallway between these two rooms. A clean and healthy environment, including furniture, materials and equipment must be provided, and the program shall be cleaned daily. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.
