Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to store chemicals and machinery in a place that is inaccessible to children. The program is required to provide an outdoor play area away from machinery in operation.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous item or toxic substance was used or stored in the unlocked staff restroom on the hutch where children had access to it, as noted in number(s) 2 and 14 below.

- 1. Bleach.
- 2. Cleaning agent (surface cleaner).
- 3. Fish tank chemicals.
- 4. Gasoline.
- 5. Pesticide.
- 6. Poison, including insect/rodent poison.
- 7. Flammable substance.

- 14. Other potentially hazardous substance, equipment or machinery: air freshener.

Provide staff training.
