1. Temperature of at least one hundred and one degrees Fahrenheit (one hundred degrees Fahrenheit if taken axillary), when

- in combination with any other sign or symptom of illness
- 2. Diarrhea as described in rule
- 3. Severe coughing as described in rule
- 4. Difficult or rapid breathing
- 5. Yellowish skin or eyes
- 6. Redness of the eye or eyelid as described in rule
- 7. Untreated infected skin patches as described in rule
- 8. Unusually dark urine or stool as described in rule
- 9. Stiff neck with elevated temperature
- 10. Evidence of lice, etc. as described in rule
- 11. Sore throat or difficulty in swallowing
- 12. Vomiting as described in rule
