Code: The program is required to place infants in cribs while sleeping.

Allegation: Infants are allowed to sleep in devices or equipment other than a crib.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the equipment in number(s) 7, 10 below had been used for sleeping infants and did not allow the infant to sleep on a firm mattress:

- 1. Mesh cribs;
- 2. Play pens;
- 3. Bassinets;
- 4. Cots;
- 5. Car seats:
- 6. Infant swing;
- 7. The floor;
- 8. Infant seats;
- 9. An infant placed in a car seat in a crib;

10. Other: Boppy pillow

Infants must be provided with a crib, which meets requirements specified in this rule, for resting and sleeping. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that staff training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-23 Infant Daily Care

Code: The program staff is required to hold infants or have the infant sitting up while feeding. The program staff may not place an infant in a crib with a bottle.

Allegation: Infants are not held or fed sitting up for bottled feedings.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not meet the requirements for bottle feeding as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. A bottle was propped for an infant feeding.
- 2. An infant was placed in a crib with a bottle.
- 3. An infant was not held or fed sitting up for bottle feedings.
