Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-12-19 Supervision



<u>Code</u>: The program staff is required to supervise children in their assigned group by sight and hearing. Supervision includes being near enough to respond and reach children immediately and protecting them from harm.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that children were left unattended while inside the program as noted in number(s) 1,3,8 below:

- 1. Child(ren) were left unattended once. (Toddler teacher left children in restroom to grab items from toddler room.)
- 2. Child(ren) were left unattended more than once.
- 3. Child(ren) left the group and were unattended. (Toddler children walked to restroom while toddler teacher was still in room.)
- 4. Child care staff were using a baby monitor to supervise children.
- 5. Child care staff were using a walkie talkie to supervise children.
- 6. Child care staff were using mirrors to view children in another room.
- 7. Child care staff were using a video camera instead of physically being present in the room.
- 8. Other (Preschool teacher was in restroom with child with back to the children in classroom and door half shut. Teacher is in a wheel chair and it appeared difficult for her to turn around properly due to limited space in restroom.) (Infant teacher was sitting in chair in play area while all infants were in sleeping space.)

Children must be supervised and within sight and hearing of a child care staff member at all times. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the equipment in number(s) 8 below had been used for sleeping infants and did not allow the infant to sleep on a firm mattress:

- 1. Mesh cribs;
- 2. Play pens;
- 3. Bassinets;
- 4. Cots;
- 5. Car seats;
- 6. Infant swing;
- 7. The floor;
- 8. Infant seats; (bouncy seat.)
- 9. An infant placed in a car seat in a crib;

Infants must be provided with a crib, which meets requirements specified in this rule, for resting and sleeping. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that staff training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
