<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that hazardous conditions existed in the outdoor play area, as noted in number(s) 2 below:

- 1. There was broken glass.
- 2. There were tall weeds.
- 3. There was poison ivy.
- 4. There were tree branches.
- 5. There was mold visible.
- 6. There were thistles with prickers.
- 7. There were bird droppings.
- 8. There were bolts with more than two threads exposed along a fence line or gate on a playground.
- 9. The sandbox was contaminated.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that children who have a bedtime routine occurring at the program were not provided with the item(s) noted in number(s) 1-3 below, as required:

- 1. Clean, individual, individually labeled washcloths.
- 2. Clean, individual, individually labeled towels.
- 3. Toothbrushes.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that sheets did not meet the rule requirement as noted in number(s) 2 below:

- 1. At least one crib did not have a sheet.
- 2. At least one sheet was too large.
- 3. At least one sheet was too small.
- 4. At least one sheet was torn.
- 5. Crib sheets were not clean.

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide mattresses that are in good condition.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that at least one crib mattress did not meet the requirements of the rule as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. The mattress was not at least one and one-half inches thick.
- 2. The mattress was not firm.
- 3. There was space between the mattress and the sides and end panels of the crib which exceeded one and one-half inches.

Discontinue the use of and replace immediately any mattress that does not meet the specified requirements in the rule. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide a safe and sufficient barrier to separate the play and sleeping space.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the barrier between the play and sleeping space did not meet the requirements as noted in number(s) 6 below:

- 1. No barrier had been provided
- 2. The barrier did not prevent the infants from entering the sleeping area.
- 3. The barrier was not safe.
- 4. The barrier was not sturdy.
- 5. The barrier impaired staff's ability to see and hear all sleeping infants in their cribs.
- 6. The barrier was inadequate.
- 7. Other [ ].

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the mattress support was not maintained at the lowest position for all cribs when in use, as required. Except when infants are being placed in cribs, removed from cribs, or being soothed, the sides should remain in the highest position. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.
