#### Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5180:2-12-18 Attendance Records

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to maintain a record of the arrival and departure of each child. The program is also required to retain the original attendance record at the center for a period of one year.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not meet the requirements for keeping an attendance record as listed in numbers 6, 7 & 9 below:

- 1. No attendance record was being maintained.
- 2. The attendance record was not being consistently completed.
- 3. The record did not include the name of at least one child.
- 4. The record did not include the birth date of at least one child.
- 5. The record did not include the assigned group.
- 6. The record did not include the child's actual weekly schedule/drop-in status.
- 7. The record did not include the time (hours and minutes) of each child's arrival and departure to the program, including transportation by the program.
- 8. The original attendance record was not kept at the program for a period of one year.
- 9. The attendance record did not remain with the group at all times.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

### Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5180:2-12-13 Handwashing Requirements

Code: The program is required to have all staff and children wash their hands as outlined in rule.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that handwashing requirements were not followed as listed in numbers 11 & 12 below, as required in rule.

- 1. At least one staff/child did not wash their hands upon arrival for the day.
- 2. At least one staff/child did not wash their hands prior to departure.
- 3. At least one staff did not wash their hands upon entry into a classroom.
- 4. At least one staff/child did not wash their hands after toileting or assisting a child with toileting.
- 5. At least one staff/child did not wash their hands after each diaper change or pull-up change.
- 6. At least one staff did not wash their hands after contact with bodily fluids or cleaning up spills or objects contaminated with bodily fluids.
- 7. At least one child did not wash their hands after contact with bodily fluids.
- 8. At least one child did not wash their hands after returning inside after outdoor play.
- 9. At least one staff did not wash their hands after cleaning or sanitizing or using any chemical products.
- 10. At least one staff/child did not wash their hands after handling pets, pet cages or other pet objects that have come in contact with the pet.



- 11. At least one staff did not wash their hands before eating, serving or preparing food or bottles or feeding a child.
- 12. At least one child did not wash their hands before eating or assisting with food preparation.
- 13. At least one staff did not wash their hands before and after completing a medical procedure or administering medication.
- 14. At least one child did not wash their hands after water activities.
- 15. At least one staff/child did not wash their hands when visibly soiled (must use soap and water).
- 16. Other [ ].

## **Domain: 06 Program Information**

Rule: 5180:2-12-14 Transportation - Vehicle Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all vehicles used to transport children inspected annually by an ASE certified mechanic, FMCSA safety inspector or the Ohio State Highway Patrol, and correct all repairs that are listed on the vehicle inspection report.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined information on the JFS 01230 "Vehicle Inspection Report For Child Care Centers" had not been completed in that the inspection date was not documented. The Administrator stated that the vehicles were inspected on the date the ASE certified mechanic signed/dated the form. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes copies of the completed JFS 01230 "Vehicle Inspection Report for Child Care Centers", to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### **Domain: 06 Program Information**

Rule: 5180:2-12-14 Transportation and Field Trip Procedures

Code: The program is required to take all required safety and health items on trips.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that all required items were not taken on a field trip and/or routine trip as determined in that the item number 1 below was missing:

- 1. Completed copies of the JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information For Child Care" (except routine walks);
- 2. First aid supplies;



- 3. A working cellular phone or other means of immediate communication (not to be used while a vehicle is in motion);
- 4. Written record of children on the trip, including which vehicle each child is being transported in and the cellular phone number of the adult in that vehicle who could be contacted in an emergency.

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a written plan that ensures these safety guidelines will be met when children are transported, and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the program's records, it was determined that requirements for written permission from the parent/guardian for a field trip or routine trip were not met as listed in number 1 below:

- 1. Written parental permission was not secured for field trips and/or routine trips off the premises.
- 2. The written permission was missing the child's name.
- 3. The written permission was missing the date(s) of the trip(s) (field trips only).
- 4. The written permission was missing the destination(s) of the trip(s).
- 5. The written permission was missing the departure and return time(s) of the trip(s) (field trips only).
- 6. The written permission was missing the signature of the parent.
- 7. The written permission was missing the date on which the permission was signed.
- 8. The written permission was missing a statement notifying parents how their child will be transported.
- 9. Permission forms for routine trips were not being updated annually.
- 10. Written parental permission forms for field trips and/or routine trips were not being maintained on file for at least one year from the date of the trip.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program's written disaster plan did not meet the requirement or was missing the information in number 20 below:

- 2. The plan was not provided to all child care staff and employees
- 3. The plan was not used to respond to an emergency or disaster situation
- 4. Weather emergencies and natural disasters which include severe thunderstorms, tornadoes, flash flooding, major snowfall, blizzards, ice storms or earthquakes



- 5. Emergency outdoor and indoor lockdown or evacuation due to threats of violence which includes active shooter, bioterrorism or terrorism
- 6. Emergency or disaster evacuations due to hazardous materials and spills, gas leaks or bomb threats.
- 7. Outbreaks, epidemics or other infectious disease emergencies
- 8. Loss of power, water, or heat
- 9. Other threatening situations that may pose a health or safety hazard to the children in the program Details:
- 10. Shelter in place or evacuation, how the program will care for and account for the children until they can be reunited with the parent
- 11. A designated safe site where staff and children can safely remain when evacuated.
- 12. Assisting infants, toddlers and children with special needs and/or health conditions
- 13. Emergency contact information for parents and the program
- 14. Procedures for notifying and communicating with parents regarding the location of the children if evacuated
- 15. Procedures for communicating with parents during loss of communications, no phone or internet service available
- 16. The location of supplies and procedures for gathering necessary supplies for staff and children if required to shelter in place
- 17. What to do if a disaster occurs during the transport of children or when on a field trip or routine trip
- 18. Making the plan available to all child care staff members and employees
- 19. Training of staff or reassignment of staff duties as appropriate
- 20. Updating the plan on a yearly basis
- 21. Contact with local emergency management officials
