Rule: 5101:2-13-25 Medication Requirements

Code: The program is required to store medication out of the reach of children.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined medications were within the reach of children. In the main child care area in a child's "cubby" was a prescription inhaler medication. Although this was on a higher shelf, the shelves below could allow a child to climb and reach the medication. In the restroom closet in a basket was a tube of medicated cream within reach of children. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-15 Health Conditions

Code: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan for Child Care" on file at the program for any child having a health condition and must implement and/or follow instructions on the plan. The program is required to have staff trained to perform the procedures on the JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan for Child Care" present at the program when the child requiring the procedure is onsite. Only staff who have been trained shall be permitted to perform the procedures listed on the JFS 01236.

Findings: In review of the children's records, it was determined the program did not meet the requirements for caring for at least one child, indicated on the Children Records Review, with a condition that requires a JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan" as noted in numbers 5, 7 and 28 below:

1. No plan was on file.

- 15. Symptoms that require staff to administer medication/medical food were missing or not attached.
- 16. Specific instructions to administer the medication/medical food were missing or not attached.
- 17. Actions to be taken if the symptoms do not subside were missing or not attached.
- 18. Physician's signature was missing or not attached.
- 19. The date of the physician's signature was missing or not attached.

- 20. Child's name was missing.
- 21. Instructions regarding emergency evacuation, if applicable, were missing.
- 22. Signature of parent granting permission to implement the plan and verifying training was missing.
- 23. Date of parent signature was missing.
- 24. Certified Professional Trainer information was missing.
- 25. Signature of certified professional who trained the program staff was missing, if parent was not the trainer.
- 26. Date of trainer signature was missing.
- 27. Printed name(s)of child care staff member(s) who have received instructions for care and/or have been trained to perform the procedure were missing.
- 28. Signature of child care staff member who have received instructions for care and/or have been trained to perform the procedure were missing.
- 29. Date of staff signature was missing.

- 40. None of the child care staff members trained in the procedures on the JFS 01236 were onsite when a child requiring the plan was present.
- 41. Child care staff members trained in the procedures on the JFS 01236 were not scheduled to be present the entire the time the child requiring the plan was onsite.
- 42. None of the child care staff members trained in the procedures on the JFS 01236 accompanied the child requiring the plan during a trip.
- 43. A child care staff member who had not been trained in the procedures on the JFS 01236 performed the procedure.
- 44. Medication listed in the procedures to follow was not onsite available to administer as instructed and alternate instructions for this situation were not included on the plan.

Rule: 5101:2-13-04 Fire Safety for Type B Homes

Code: The program is required to follow all requirements in rule regarding emergency exits and operational conditions.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the following requirements regarding emergency exits and operational conditions were not met by the program, in that there was no documentation of a secondary escape route on the second floor on the posted fire evacuation floor plan. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following item in which may threaten their health, safety, or well being as noted in the following number 22 below:

- 1. Surge protectors/outlets did not have childproof receptacle covers.
- 2. Open pull cords that are not closed loop.
- 3. Toys or other items small enough to be swallowed were present in the space where infants and/or toddlers were in care.
- 4. Electrical/extension cords attached to an object that would not likely result in a severe injury if pulled.
- 5. Stacked chairs.
- 6. Telephone cords.
- 7. Employee(s) purse(s).
- 8. Diaper bags.
- 9. Television not securely anchored.
- 10. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.
- 11. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child.
- 12. Chipping or peeling paint.
- 13. An area rug did not have a nonskid backing.
- 14. An area rug presented a tripping hazard.
- 15. A floor surface was unsafe in that [].
- 16. No platform was provided for the sink or toilet.
- 17. The platform provided for the sink or toilet was not sturdy.
- 18. The platform provided for the sink or toilet posed a safety hazard in that [].
- 19. Emergency exits were blocked by the following furniture in that [].
- 20. A mercury thermometer was being used to take a child's temperature.
- 21. Methods of ventilation used did not provide protection from rodents, insects, or other hazards.
- 22. Other, in the restroom closet there was a razor in a basket within reach of children.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-08 Child Care Staff Requirements

Code: The program is required to have staff complete the online staff orientation training. Additionally, the training must be completed before they are permitted to have sole responsibility of children.

Findings: In review of the staff records, it was determined that child care staff member or substitute child care staff member did not meet the requirements for completing the online orientation training as noted in number 4 below:

- 1. The training was not completed within 30 days of starting employment at the program as a child care staff member.
- 2. No documentation of completing the training after December 31, 2016.

- 3. Completion of the training was not verified in the OPR.
- 4. A child care staff member had sole responsibility of children and had not completed the online orientation.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-25 Medication Requirements

Code: The program is required to discard or return medication, medical foods, and/or topical products that are no longer being administered or have expired. The program is also required to maintain current documentation to administer medication, medical foods, and topical products.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined medication, medical foods and/or topical products did not meet the requirement(s) for administering medication, medical foods, and/or medical products as noted in number 3 below:

- 1. The medication, medical food, or topical product was no longer needed and had not been removed from the program.
- 2. The medication, medical food, or topical product had expired and had not been removed from the program.
- 3. The prescription label had expired.

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.
