Rule: 5180:2-12-25 Medication Administration

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to store medication out of the reach of children.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that a medication, in the office, was within the reach of children in the toddler room. All medications must be stored out of the reach of children. Create procedures that assure medications will always be inaccessible to children. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Code: The program is required to have an outdoor play space free from trash and foreign objects.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the outdoor play space was not free of trash or foreign objects as noted in number(s) 15 below:

- 1. The outdoor area was littered with trash.
- 2. The trash can was missing a lid.
- 3. The trash can was not emptied from the day(s) before.
- 4. The trash can was overflowing with trash.
- 5. The trash can was infested with insects.
- 6. The trash can was visibly dirty.
- 7. There was broken glass.
- 8. There were tall weeds.
- 9. There was poison ivy.
- 10. There were tree branches.
- 11. There was mold visible.
- 12. There were thistles with prickers.
- 13. There were bird droppings.
- 14. The sandbox was contaminated.
- 15. Turf was bunched up and created a tripping hazard.
